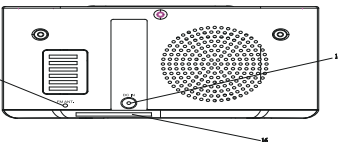
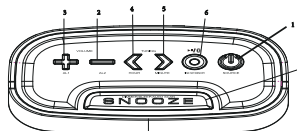
DUAL ALARM CLOCK RADIO WITH BLUETOOTH

INSTRUCTION MANUAL

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Setting Clock

1. In standby mode, press and hold the MEMORY & TIME SET BUTTON
 2. The hours will blink. Press TUNING DOWN & HOUR BUTTON to set the current hour.
 3. Press the TUNING UP & MINUTE BUTTON to set the current minute.
 4. Press MEMORY & TIME SET BUTTON once and the current time is set.
- NOTE: The PM indicator will light when the hour is set in the PM.

Setting Sleep Timer

When listening to radio, press SNOOZE & SLEEP & DIMMER & AUTO SCAN BUTTON to enter sleep mode. You can just adjust the sleep timer from 10 to 90 minutes by pressing the SNOOZE & SLEEP & AUTO SCAN & DIMMER BUTTON

The unit will automatically turn off after the selected time expires.

Playing FM Radio

1. Press the POWER BUTTON to turn the clock radio on
2. Press TUNING UP & MINUTE BUTTON and TUNING UP & MINUTE BUTTON to adjust the radio to desired frequency.
3. Press and hold the TUNING DOWN & HOUR BUTTON and TUNING UP & MINUTE BUTTON to search for the next available frequency
4. Press AND hold the POWER BUTTON to turn the clock radio off.

Saving a Station as Preset

1. Follow the instructions for Tuning the FM Radio.
2. Tune to the desired station
3. Press and hold the MEMORY & TIME SET BUTTON to save the current radio station as a preset.

Tuning to a Preset Radio Station

1. Follow the instructions for Tuning the radio and saving a station as a preset.
2. Press the MEMORY & TIME SET BUTTON to cycle through preset radio stations.

Notes:
* Adjust the position of the FM antenna to improve FM Radio reception.

Bluetooth Playback

1. Power on the unit by pressing the POWER BUTTON.
2. Press the SOURCE BUTTON switch to Bluetooth Mode
3. Press the PLAY/PAUSE/BLUETOOTH PAIR BUTTON and the BLUETOOTH INDICATOR will blink quickly.
4. Using the native controls on your Bluetooth devices, select the SCR3130BT in your Bluetooth settings to pair.
5. If your device requested a password, enter the default password 0000.
6. When successfully paired and connected, the pairing indicator will be solid.
7. After successfully pairing to a device, use the native controls on the connected bluetooth device to playback music.

Setting the Alarm

1. If in radio mode, press and hold the POWER BUTTON to turn the unit off.
2. Press the VOLUME DOWN & ALARM TWO BUTTON or VOLUME UP & ALARM ONE BUTTON.
3. Press the TUNING DOWN & HOUR BUTTON to adjust the hour.
4. Press the TUNING UP & MINUTE BUTTON to adjust the minute.
5. Press the VOLUME UP & ALARM ONE or VOLUME DOWN & ALARM TWO BUTTON repeatedly to switch between Radio Buzzer (b) or off.
6. Once the set alarm time is reached, the alarm will sound.
7. To set the other alarm, follow the above steps and choose the alarm not currently set. Cancelling the Alarm

1. Follow the instructions for Setting the Alarm.
2. Press the VOLUME DOWN & ALARM TWO BUTTON or VOLUME UP & ALARM ONE BUTTON repeatedly until the display show "OFF" and volume will no longer lit.
3. Press SNOOZE & SLEEP & DIMMER & AUTO SCAN BUTTON to delay for an additional 9 minutes. Press POWER BUTTON to turn the alarm off until the set alarm time is reached again.

Care and Maintenance

1. Clean the unit with a soft, damp (never wet) cloth. Solvent or detergent should never be used.
2. Avoid operating your unit under direct sunlight or in hot, humid or dusty places to reduce the risk of fire or electric shock.
3. Keep your unit away from heating appliances and sources of electrical noise such as fluorescent lamps or motors.
4. For better clock display clarity, avoid operating the unit under direct sunlight or in strong room illumination. Use the AC adapter from the unit and the electrical power outlet immediately in case of malfunction.

Troubleshooting Guide

Symptom	Possible Cause	Solution
Noise or sound distorted on FM broadcast	Station not tuned properly for FM. FM Telescopic antenna is not fully extended.	Fine tune the FM broadcast station. FM Telescopic antenna is not fully extended the FM Telescopic antenna.
FM no sound	Volume at minimum	Increase Volume

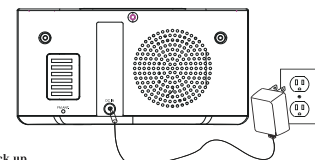
