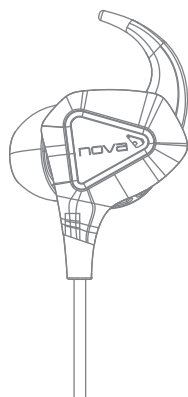

1.Introduction

Thank you for purchasing our ANC & Bluetooth in-ear headphone: NOVA. This device can be easily connected with smartphone, tablet PC and other devices via bluetooth during your traveling and daily usage. It will bring you an easy.

2.Battery Precaution

The device can be powered by a built-in rechargeable lithium battery. Please charge the battery for at least 8 hours before your first use of device.

If the device is not used for a long period of time, the battery may be out of power. Please charge the battery.

* Rechargeable battery is only to be charged under adult supervision.

* Use only the supplied cable to recharge the battery . Improper charging

* may damage the battery and the device.

* Do not attempt to open the rechargeable battery or battery pack. There are no serviceable parts inside.

* Should a battery leak, the device may become damaged. Clean the battery compartment immediately, avoiding touching your skin.

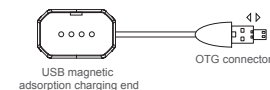
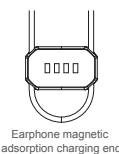
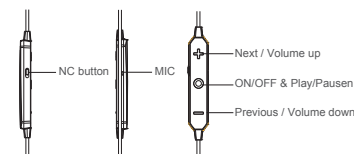
* Keep the battery out of reach from children. If swallowed, consult a physician immediately.

4.Bluetooth Connection

Pairing earphone to your device (device should be within 10 meters of your earphone)

1.Activate pairing mode on earphone by long pressing Play/Pause button. The LED will flash quickly in blue and red alternately.

2.On your device, navigate to the Bluetooth function (refer to the device

owner's manual to locate Bluetooth function).

3.Select "Set Up" Bluetooth or turn "ON" Bluetooth.

4.Select "Search" or "Discover" devices.

5.Select "NOVA".

6.If requested, type the password or PIN 0000

7.Press the Enter key.

After completing the steps above, a message on your device will appear confirming that your device is now paired/ connected.

In case of unsuccessful pairing, long press the middle button to off and restart it to on.

If you turn off the device, but the Bluetooth on your device remains open, when you restart the device, the Bluetooth will be connected automatically.

5.Function Guidance

Power on	Long press power button 3s	Blue light flash slowly
Power off	Long press power button 3s when power on	Blue light off
Bluetooth connection	1. long press "ON/OFF" button	Blue light flash quickly
	2.remind it to search for your device	Blue light flash slowly, connection success
	3.If requested, type the pass word or PIN0000	Blue light flash slowly, connection success
ANC on	Switch NC Button	White Light on
ANC off	Switch NC Button	White Light off
Volume up	Press button "+"	Volume up
Volume down	Press button "-"	Volume down
Play/Pause	Press power button once	
Previous song	Long press button "*" three times	Previous song
Next song	Long press button "*" twice	Next song
End a call	Press MFB button once	
Answer a call	Press MFB button once	Ring will stop automatically when you answer a call
Refuse a call	Long press MFB button 3s	Refuse answering a call

6.Battery Charging

The device has a built-in rechargeable battery. This can be charged by USB cable connected with your computer. When it's charging, the light near the USB port will turn to red

After charging, the device can be used without the power connection.

7.Product care

Your device is designed to be light, compact and durable. As an electronic device it must be treated carefully. Putting unnecessary pressure on it or striking the device against other objects may cause damage. To avoid damaging your device, please

* Do not drop, crush, bend or apply excessive force to the device.

* Do not expose your device to moisture, extreme or prolonged heat, cold, humidity, or other adverse conditions. Avoid storing it in damp, humid or wet places.

* Clean the unit with a soft cloth or damp chamois leather. Never use solvents.

* The Unit can only be opened by qualified personnel.

* This device contains magnets. Keep magnetic field sensitive products such as credit cards and video screen away from this device to avoid damage or malfunction.

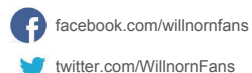
