#### 2. Test Procedure

**GENERAL**: This report shall NOT be reproduced except in full without the written approval of Shenzhen Anbotek Compliance Laboratory Limited. The EUT was transmitting a test signal during the testing.

**RADIATION INTERFERENCE**: The test procedure used was ANSI STANDARD C63.4-2009 using a spectrum analyzer with a pre-selector. The analyzer was calibrated in dB above a microvolt at the output of the antenna. The resolution bandwidth was 100KHz and the video bandwidth was 300KHz up to 1.0GHz and 1.0MHz with a video BW of 3.0MHz above 1.0GHz. The ambient temperature of the EUT was 74.3oF with a humidity of 69%.

**FORMULA OF CONVERSION FACTORS**: The Field Strength at 3m was established by adding the meter reading of the spectrum analyzer (which is set to read in units of dBuV) to the antenna correction factor supplied by the antenna manufacturer. The antenna correction factors are stated in terms of dB. The gain of the Preselector was accounted for in the Spectrum Analyzer Meter Reading.

#### Example:

Freq (MHz) METER READING + ACF = FS 20 dBuV + 10.36 dB = 30.36 dBuV/m @ 3m

**ANSI STANDARD C63.4-2009 10.1.7 MEASUREMENT PROCEDURES**: The EUT was placed on a table 80 cm high and with dimensions of 1m by 1.5m. The EUT was placed in the center of the table (1.5m side). The table used for radiated measurements is capable of continuous rotation.

When an emission was found, the table was rotated to produce the maximum signal strength. At this point, the antenna was raised and lowered from 1m to 4m. The antenna was placed in both the horizontal and vertical planes.





#### 3.3. Configuration of EUT on Measurement

The following equipments are installed on Power Line Conducted Emission Measurement to meet the commission requirement and operating regulations in a manner which tends to maximize its emission characteristics in a normal application.

### 3.4. Operating Condition of EUT

- 3.4.1. Setup the EUT and simulator as shown as Section 3.1.
- 3.4.2. Turn on the power of all equipment.
- 3.4.3. Let the EUT work in test mode (Charging to adapter) and measure it.



#### 3.5. Test Procedure

The EUT system is connected to the power mains through a line impedance stabilization network (L.I.S.N.). This provides a 50ohm coupling impedance for the EUT system. Please refer the block diagram of the test setup and photographs. Both sides of AC line are checked to find out the maximum conducted emission. In order to find the maximum emission levels, the relative positions of equipment and all of the interface cables shall be changed according to FCC ANSI C63.4-2003 on Conducted Emission Measurement.

The bandwidth of test receiver (ESCI) set at 9KHz.

The frequency range from 150KHz to 30MHz is checked.

The test results are reported on Section 3.6.





For range 9KHz~30MHz, The measured value is really too low to be recorded.

Emissions radiated outside of the specified frequency bands, except for harmonics, shall be attenuated by at least 50 dB below the level of the fundamental or to the general radiated emission limits in 15.209, whichever is the lesser attenuation.

#### 4.2. Test Procedure

The EUT is placed on a turn table which is 0.8 meter high above the ground. The turn table can rotate 360 degrees to determine the position of the maximum emission level. The EUT is set 3 meters away from the receiving antenna which is mounted on a antenna tower. The antenna can be moved up and down from 1 to 4 meters to find out the maximum emission level. Both horizontal and vertical polarization of the antenna are set on test.

All readings from 30MHz to 1GHz are quasi-peak values with a resolution bandwidth of 120kHz. All reading are above 1GHz, peak & average values with a resolution bandwidth of 1MHz. The EUT is tested in 9\*6\*6 Chamber.



## 5. Occupied Bandwidth

#### 5.1. Requirements (15.249):

The field strength of any emissions appearing outside the band edges and up to 10 kHz above and below the band edges shall be attenuated at least 50 dB below the level of the carrier or to the general limits of 15.249.

The EUT is placed on a turn table which is 0.8 meter high above the ground. The turn table can rotate 360 degrees to determine the position of the maximum emission level. The EUT is set 3 meters away from the receiving antenna which is mounted on a antenna tower. The antenna can be moved up and down from 1 to 4 meters to find out the maximum emission level. Both horizontal and vertical polarization of the antenna are set on test.

The EUT- Front View




The EUT- Back View










The EUT- Bottom View










The EUT-Inside View



The EUT-Inside View



The EUT-Inside View





Figure 10 PCB of the EUT-Front View










Figure 12 PCB of the EUT-Front View
