

CHARGING THE SPEAKER

- Connect the USB Cable (included) to the Micro USB Port on the speaker.
- With the speaker power off, plug the other end of USB Cable into a USB Port on your PC or a 5V 1A adapter (not included).
- 3. The Battery LED Indicator light will illuminate white while charging and all the LED Indicators will turn solid white when speaker is fully charged. Charges in approximately 3 hours for up to 12 hours of listening enjoyment.

NOTE: When battery is low, the speaker will sound a beep tone every minute.

TURNING THE SPEAKER ON/

- Press and hold the Power Button for 2 seconds. The speaker is turned on and will sound ascending tones.
- Press and hold the Power Button for 2 seconds again. The speaker will sound descending tones and power off.

NOTE: With the speaker power on or off, short press the Power Button once, the Battery LED Indidcator(s) will lit on for 16 seconds to show the battery level.

PLAYING MUSIC THROUGH A WIRED CONNECTION

You can connect your audio device to the speaker with a 3.5mm audio cable (not included).

- Plug one end of the cable into your audio device, just like you would a pair of headphones.
- Plug the other end of the cable into the speaker's Aux-In port. The Power LED Indicator will illuminate red.
- 3. Use your audio device to control music playback, and adjust volume through speaker.

PAIRING YOUR DEVICE

- Prepare your device to pair using Bluetooth® technology, making sure you are within 33 feet of the speaker Refer to your device's owners manual for details if necessary.
- 2. Turn on the speaker.
- 3. Power LED Indicator will flash blue and the speaker is ready to pair.
- 4. Once the speaker is in pairing mode and your device is ready to pair, select 'Executive 2.0.' If prompted, use 0000 as a PIN for the pairing code. Once the speaker is selected, the speaker will sound tones and the blue light will become solid to confirm pairing is complete.

NOTES:

- Aux-in will take priority over the Bluetooth® connection. When Aux cable is unplugged, the speaker will reconnect to the phone via Bluetooth®. A tone will sound and Power LED Indicator will turn solid blue again.
- You can connect the speaker to other Bluetooth® enabled devices by holding the Play/Pause Button.
 The Power LED Indicator will flash blue and the speaker is in pairing mode again.

LISTENING TO YOUR AUDIO DEVICE

- Play your audio device as you normally would.
- Volume may be adjusted on your audio device or by pressing and holding the Volume Down or Volume Up buttons.
- A single press of the Volume Down or Volume Up buttons will go back to the previous track or advance to the next track.
- To pause audio, press the Power Button on the Speaker. To resume audio playback, press the same button again.

CHARGING YOUR SMARTPHONE

Connect your phone's USB charging cable to the USB-OUT Port on the speaker for charging your device.

MOBILE PHONE OPERATION

- When you have an incoming call, the speaker sounds an incoming call tone. Both the speaker and your mobile phone may ring, depending on your mobile phone settings.
- 2. To answer an incoming call press and release the Power Button.
- 3. To end a call press and release the Power Button.
- When you receive a call, while music is playing, the song will pause. After ending the call, the song will continue from where it was paused.
