Portable Internet Radio



Model: WR-26

Please read this user manual carefully before using the receiver



It will start scanning the available Wi-Fi networks around. Scroll to your network and press [OK] to confirm. If your Wi-Fi network has a password protected, it will ask you to enter the password / password.

Here are the steps to enter the password. Use the [▲▼] button to scroll through the characters. When the correct one is highlighted, press the [▶] button to move the next character. When it comes to the last character of the password and it is highlighted, press [OK] to confirm.

Note: The password is case sensitive. Please consult with the one who set up your network if you don't know the password.

When the Wi-Fi connection is successful, the Association Complete will be shown briefly. It will then display the main menu as follows:



Overview of features and functions

Press [▲] to enter the main menu. Scroll by [▲▼] buttons and OK to select.

My Favourite - To show the list of favorite stations which have been assigned to the presets.

There are up to 99 presets available.

Internet Radio - Start exploring the worldwide radio stations and music here.

Media Centre - You can browse and stream music from your network via UPnP or DLNA compatible devices.

DAB Radio - Pick up DAB+ and DAB radio signal if available in your local area (no internet connection required).

FM Radio - Receive ordinary FM radio stations in your local area (no internet connection required).

Bluetooth playback

Before transmission between your Bluetooth device and the radio is possible, both devices must be coupled. This process is called "pairing". The radio is served as a receiver, to receive music stream to play on the radio.

If you have already coupled to a Bluetooth device before, this connection will be restored automatically when both devices are in range and Bluetooth operation has been selected on the radio. "Pairing" does not have to be repeated. This function may need to be activated in your Bluetooth device, however:

- Press the [▲] button to display the selection menu for the different operating modes.
- Use the [▲▼] button to select the operating mode Bluetooth and press OK to confirm.
- Switch your Bluetooth device to which you want to connect the radio on and activate the pairing mode here. The device scans for Bluetooth devices in the reception range.
- When the radio is found, your Bluetooth device shows its name WR-26-XXXX (the XXXX is an identification code for your radio unit).
- Select the radio at your Bluetooth device.
- Start playback on your Bluetooth device.
- Playback now takes place using the radio.

Sleep Timer Setting

You can set the timer to let the radio goes standby after the selected time elapsed in the range of 15 minutes to 180 minutes.

On the main menu, choose Sleep Timer and press [OK]. Choose your desired time period and press [OK] to confirm. You will see the "Z" icon appeared on the top row under the status menu (press [▶] button under the playing screen to view the status menu).

To see the time remains for sleep timer, choose Sleep Timer on the main menu and press [OK]. It will show the time left to go standby.



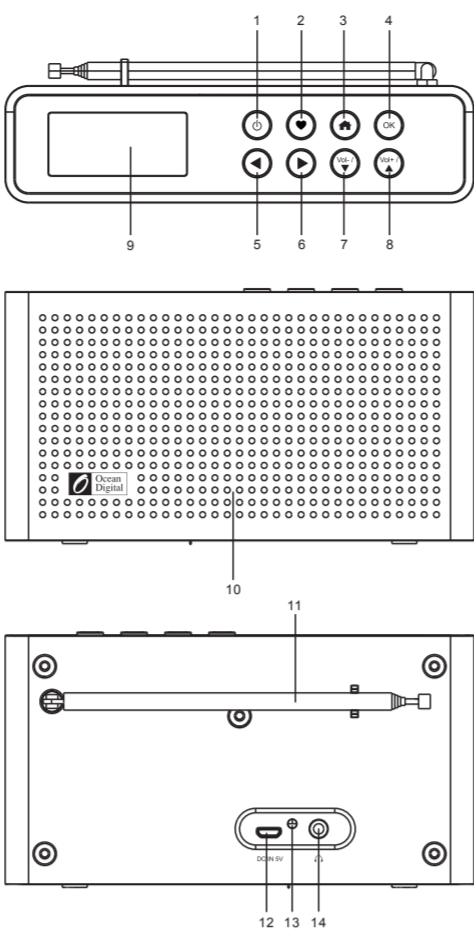
Problem	Cause	Solutions
Network down		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Confirm that a Wi-Fi or Ethernet wired connected PC can access the internet (i.e. can browse the web) using the same network. Check that a DHCP server is available, or that you have configured a static IP address on the radio. Check that your firewall is not blocking any outgoing ports. As a minimum the radio needs access to UDP and TCP ports 80, 443 and 8008, DNS port 53.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi network	Router restricts access to listed MAC addresses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Obtain the MAC address from Configuration > Information > Network > Wi-Fi MAC and add to the allowed equipment list on your access point. Note: The radio has separate MAC address for wireless networks.
	Insufficient Wi-Fi signal strength	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Check distance to router: see if a computer can connect to the network in this location. Optimize the distance of the router's location. Always place the radio close to the router within 2 meters to setup.
	Unknown encryption method	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Change encryption method on router. The radio supports WEP, WPA, WPA2.
	Firewall preventing access	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Windows Media Player: varies—non-Microsoft fire walls may require configuration for UPnP. Try other routers and see if the radio can connect, or if hotspot is available on your mobile device, try to see if it connects.

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Location of controls



1. [○] Press and hold to power on/off
2. [♥] Press and hold to add station to favourite
Press and release to recall the favourite list
3. [▲] Return to main menu / return to the playing screen
4. [OK] Confirm selection
Stop playback / resume playback under Internet radio
Menu under DAB, FM and Bluetooth
5. [◀] Navigation / Exit to the previous menu
Skip to the previous song under Bluetooth
6. [▶] Navigation / Enter edit menu under Favourite list
Skip to the previous song under Bluetooth
On the radio playing screen, press the [▶] button to view the clock, battery level and radio information
7. [▼] Reduce volume level / Press and hold to decrease the volume level consecutively / Navigation
8. [Vol+ / ▲] Increase volume level / Press and hold to increase the volume level consecutively / Navigation
9. [Display]
10. [Speaker]
11. [Antenna]
12. [USB port for charging internal battery]
13. [LED indicator for battery charging status]
14. [Earphone socket]

Search - Instead of browsing the radio station list, you can input a few characters of the desired station to filter out / shorten list the stations.

History - The radio memorizes the stations you have listened up to 99 stations. It will supersede the first station that you have listened.

Start playing internet radio - When it starts playing a radio station, various information will be displayed.



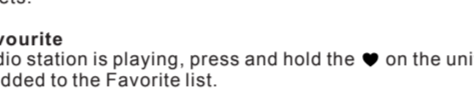
Under the playing screen, press the [▶] button, it will display the date and time, as well as the battery level indicator.



Note: Whenever you want to return to the playing screen from other menu, press the [○] or the [▶] repeatedly or wait for the time out.

My Favourite - This is to show the list of your Favorite stations which have been assigned to the presets.

Add to Favourite - When a radio station is playing, press and hold the [♥] on the unit, the station is added to the Favourite list.



You can store up to 99 presets. The new added station will always appear in the last item on the Favorite list.

Recall a station - Press and release the [♥] button on the radio unit to recall the favourite list or navigate to **My Favourite** on the main menu and select it to confirm.

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Edit your favorite list - On the Favorite list, choose the radio station you want to edit then press the [▶] button. It will enter the Edit menu with the following options: Move down - To move down the ranking of a station
Move up - To move up the ranking of a station
Delete - To delete a particular station

Media Centre

The device supports UPnP and is DLNA-compatible.

On the Favorite list, choose the radio station you want to edit then press the [▶] button. It will enter the Edit menu with the following options: Move down - To move down the ranking of a station
Move up - To move up the ranking of a station
Delete - To delete a particular station

Media streaming - Once the UPnP/DLNA compatible server is configured to share media files with your radio, you can start music streaming.

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
