RE: Request for Confidentiality for Documents Submitted with Equipment Authorization for FCC ID 2ABD7-5363

To Whom This May Concern:

VIOLET L.L.C. and its affiliates (collectively, "VIOLET") seek protection of specific confidential materials and information we're otherwise required to include in VIOLET's submission for equipment authorization for our product with the FCC ID 2ABD7-5363 (the "Device").

Confidential Protection - Short Term Only

VIOLET asks that the following information be kept confidential for 180 days from the date we submit our equipment authorization for the Device, as allowed under the FCC's Public Notice of June 15, 2004 (DA 04-1705) and under the marketing regulations under 47 CFR Section 2.803 and 47 CFR Section 2.1204:

- User manual
- Test set-up pictures
- Internal and external pictures of the Device

We seek this protection on the basis that we do not share this information with any third party unless we have a written agreement that obligates the third party to keep this information as confidential. Any disclosure of this information before VIOLET itself announced or starts marketing/selling the Device would give others access to inside information about our product plans and would negatively impact VIOLET's business and VIOLET's ability to compete with other companies in this space.

Confidential Protection - Indefinite Term

VIOLET asks that the following information be kept confidential on an indefinite basis from the date we submit our equipment authorization for the above product, as allowed under 47 CFR Section 0.457 and 47 CFR Section 0.459 and related rules of the FCC,:

- Wi-Fi operational manual/description
- Block diagram
- Schematics

Unlike the information covered above under the short term protection request, these materials are never made publicly available. This information reflects highly confidential information about how VIOLET designed, manufactured and tests/will test the Device that, if shared, would have a significant negative impact on VIOLET's business and give others an unfair commercial advantage over VIOLET. It would also place VIOLET at a distinct disadvantage over others offering similar products as the Device.

Further, this information that VIOLET only shares with those how have an absolute need to know this information and only under written agreements that obligate the recipients to keep this information as confidential.

VIOLET appreciates the FCC's support of its request for confidential treatment of the above confidential information. Of course, if there are any objections, please contact me to discuss.
