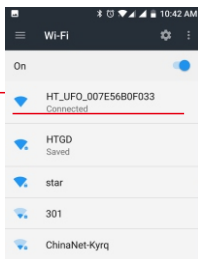

Click the "Settings" in the first page to enter the settings page. You can set up partial parameters.

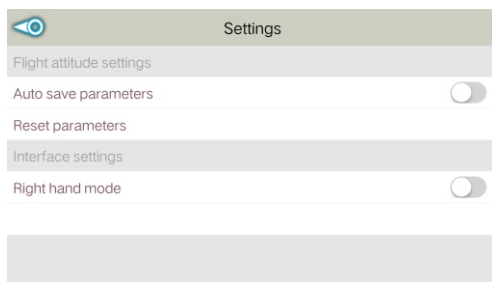

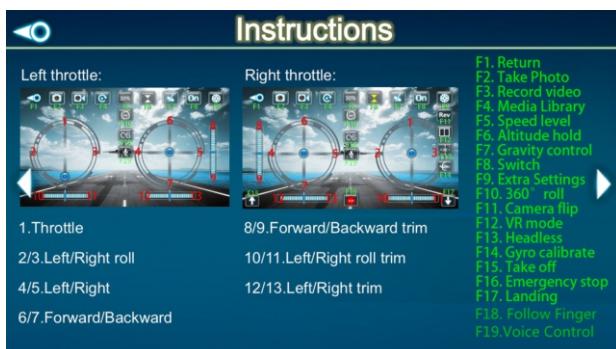
