Caution and Safety

Charging Instructions

- 1. Insert one end of USB charging cable into power adaptor or computer.

- 2. Open the Bluetooth in your phone, select" BT SPEAKER",
- It will pair with your phone automatically.
- 3. Play music
- 4. Slide the power switch to OFF position when not using.
