
USER MANUAL Fan Bluetooth speaker

Charging Instruction

- Insert one end of USB charging cable into power adaptor or computer.
- 2. Insert the other end of USB charging cable into Micro USB port on the speaker.
- The LED indicator light will light red to indicate charging and turn off when fully charged.

Bluetooth speaker operation

- 1. Hold down the Power Button for 3 or more seconds to turn on the speaker.
- 2. Open tBluetooth Settings on your device, select" SP83", it will pair with your phone automatically.
- 3. Play music.

4. Hold down the Power Button for 3 or more seconds to turn off the speaker

Fan operation

Short press the Fan control button successively to switch the Level and turn off : Level 1 — Level 2 — Level 3 — Off

- 1. Please read the instructions carefully before using.
- 2. Avoid touch with liquids; keep away from water.
- 3. Do not near heat sources such as radiators, heaters, air ₄ ducts, or direct sunlight.
