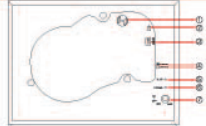

1. 7 Inch Adaptor
2. Cueing Lever
3. Speed / Record RPM selector switch
4. Bluetooth ON/OFF switch
5. LED Bluetooth indicator light
6. LED power indicator light
7. [O] Power ON/OFF button / volume knob

Pairing the Speaker

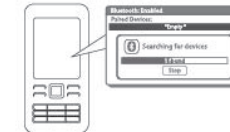
On a BlackBerry
 • Go to **SETTINGS>OPTIONS > BLUETOOTH**
 • Enable **BLUETOOTH**



On an Android Phone
 • Go to **SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH > MENU**
 Search for devices (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)



On other Cell Phones/Devices
 • Review the instruction manual that came with your phone/device.



5. When your mobile device has completed scanning, select **T2** from the list of discovered devices.
6. If required, type the password **0000** (four zeros). Select **OK** or **YES** on your mobile device to pair the two units.
7. After a successful registration, a tone will be heard and the LED Bluetooth indicator light will remain **BLUE**.

NOTE: If you would like to connect the turntable to another device, you must unpair them from the currently paired device first. In your mobile device's Bluetooth settings, select **"SBT4001"**, then select **"unpair"**. When the turntable has been Unpaired, it will automatically go into pairing mode.

i The screenshots above are typical of many Bluetooth-enabled devices in the market today, and are used to assist in the explanation of the pairing process. Your Bluetooth-enabled device's interface and interaction with the speaker may slightly differ from the illustrations above.

On an iPhone
 • Go to **SETTINGS > BLUETOOTH**
 (Make sure Bluetooth is turned ON)

Connecting the Speakers

1. Connect the first speaker to the RCA right speaker output located on the back of the turntable.
2. Connect the other speaker to the RCA left speaker output.
3. Connect the small end of the AC Adaptor into the Adaptor port
4. Plug the AC Adaptor into a wall outlet.
5. Turn the [O] button to the **ON** position

Pairing the Speaker

1. Turn the [O] button/Volume Knob to the right to turn the unit **ON**.
2. Slide the [B] Bluetooth ON/OFF switch to the **ON** position. A tone will be heard and the LED Bluetooth indicator light will flash **BLUE**.
3. Make sure that your mobile device's Bluetooth function is turned **ON**. Open your device's Bluetooth settings and scan for other Bluetooth devices.
4. Keep the turntable and your Bluetooth-enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.

NOTE: If there are no paired devices in range when the speaker is turned on, it will go into pairing mode automatically. If a paired device is in range, the speaker will connect to it automatically.

BACK

Using the Turntable with a paired Bluetooth device

- Turn the [O] button to the right to turn the unit **ON**. Turn it all the way to the left to turn the unit **OFF**.
- Move the [B] Bluetooth ON/OFF switch to the **ON** position. If you have already paired your Bluetooth-enabled device to the turntable, it will automatically connect. A tone will be heard and the LED Bluetooth indicator light will remain **BLUE**.
- If you are using the turntable for the first time, go to the **"Pairing the Turntable to a Bluetooth-enabled device"** section of this user manual and pair the turntable to your desired Bluetooth device.
- Open your mobile device's media player and select a song from your music playlist.

i Use your media player's playback controls to play, pause and skip music tracks. Volume can be controlled by your mobile device and the turntable's volume knob.

Adjusting the volume

- Turn the [O] button/Volume Knob to the left (MIN) to decrease the volume.
- Turn the [O] button/Volume Knob to the right (MAX) to increase the volume.

Playing Vinyl records

- Turn the [O] button/Volume Knob to the left to turn the turntable **ON**.
- If your turntable is in Bluetooth mode, slide the [B] Bluetooth ON/OFF switch to the **OFF** position.
- Place a record on the turntable.
- Use the Cueing lever to raise the needle.
- Place the needle over the record.
- Use the cueing lever to lower the needle onto the record.

i The 45 RPM Adaptor is used to play smaller 7 inch (45 RPM) records on larger turntables. Place the adaptor on the turntable's spindle first then place the 45 RPM record on the turntable.

NOTE: To select another record, Use the cueing lever to raise the needle and place it in the standby position. When the turntable stops moving, remove the record and place another one on the turntable.

Troubleshooting Tips

i I can pair the Turntable Speaker with my Bluetooth device, but I cannot hear any music.

1. Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile.
2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.
3. You may have to unpair the speaker, then re-pair to your device.

i My Bluetooth device is not able to pair with the Turntable Speaker.

1. Turn the [O] button/Volume Knob to the right to turn the unit **ON**.
2. Slide the [B] Bluetooth ON/OFF switch to the **ON** position. A tone will be heard and the LED Bluetooth indicator light will flash **BLUE**.

Troubleshooting Tips (cont'd)

3. Make sure that your mobile device's Bluetooth function is turned **ON**. Open your device's Bluetooth settings and scan for other Bluetooth devices.
4. Keep the turntable and your Bluetooth-enabled device within 3 feet of each other

i I cannot get the speaker into pairing mode.

1. Make sure the speaker is turned **ON** before beginning the pairing process.
2. Make sure that your device's Bluetooth feature is powered **ON** and ready to search for Bluetooth devices.
3. Make sure the speaker is fully charged.
