



Introduction

Sonostar SmartWatch allows you to keep your phone in your pocket and stay up to date. It connects with your smartphone via Bluetooth and displays notifications such as incoming calls, messages, calendar reminders, email, Facebook updates, tweets, and more.

The SmartWatch is compatible with iOS (iPhone) and most Android operating systems. Compatibility information for your SmartWatch is available at www.sonostar.com.

Overview



1 Power/ Front Light Button:

- Press for 3 seconds to turn the watch on/off.
- ② Press briefly to turn the front light on and off.

2 Menu/ Bluetooth Button:

- ③ Press briefly to go back to the application screen.
- Press for 3 seconds to turn the Bluetooth connection on/off.


3 Watch Face:

Touch to go back to Watch Face (Time Mode).

4 Back:

Touch to go to the previous screen.

Charging



Please charge your Sonostar Watch for 3 hours before using it for the first time.

Charging Your Smartwatch:

- Please attach the magnetic side of the USB charging cable to the underside of SmartWatch (Fig.a).
- The charging cable must be plugged into the USB Hub of your computer.
- The Sonostar Smartwatch should be charged for 3 hours.
- * Warning: Please do not charge the SmartWatch over 24 hours.

Getting Started

Step 1 Turning on the Sonostar Watch

Turn on your watch by pressing the power button for 3 seconds.

Step 2 Install the Sonostar App

Download and install the Sonostar Watch App on your phone from the App Store or Google Play.

*Note: The Sonostar App is available for phones running Android version 2.3 and later/ iOS 6 and later.

Step 3 Pairing the Sonostar Watch with Your Smartphone

Go to the smartphone settings and turn the Bluetooth on. Place your smartphone close to your SmartWatch. The distance between SmartWatch and smartphone should be within 10m (30 feet) with no walls or obstructions.



Search and tap the "Sonostar" from the Bluetooth devices list on your phone.



A group of codes will be displayed on both your smartphone and watch. If the codes match, tap "Pair" on the watch first and the phone.





A pop-up message will appear and you will be prompted for permission to access the information on your smartphone. Tap "OK" to initialize the Bluetooth connection.



After the Bluetooth is connected, you will be able to use the Sonostar Apps.

Definitions of the Watch Touch Screen

There are two main views on the watch, the watch face (Time mode screen) and the Application menu. You can switch between these two views by pressing the Menu button briefly, and then tap one of the app icons to launch it.





Using Sonostar SmartWatch

The Time mode screen will be displayed after you turn on the SmartWatch. Once the unit has been paired with your device you can then switch between the Time mode and the Application screen.

Receiving lifestyle and social networking notifications

When you get calls, messages and other updates on your phone, you can receive notifications on your SmartWatch with a slight vibration. The Sonostar App gives you selective control of the notifications you would like to receive, or not receive on the SmartWatch.

You can use the functions of your SmartWatch by downloading the "Sonostar" App from Google Play or the Apple App Store.

Calls

Incoming caller ID along with a decline button will appear on the Sonostar screen with a vibrating alert.

Messages

A vibrating alert informs you when messages come in. You can receive and read your texts directly on your Smart-Watch.

Email

Don't miss a single e-mail: lets you read and manage your e-mail in any situation.

Music

You can control your music volume, play, pause, and stop your music and switch songs directly on Sonostar display.

Facebook

All your friends' posts will be shown on your wrist. Sonostar gives you notifications of all the updates you receive, without having to check your phone. Check and like all your friends' posts directly on the SmartWatch.

Updating SmartWatch

Update your SmartWatch to the most recent software version to optimize performance and get the latest enhancements. If available, a pop-up window may appear on your phone,

asking you to update your SmartWatch to the latest firmware version. Tap "Update" to confirm.

Customer Support

SmartWatch shut down unprompted.

- The battery level is too low. Charge your SmartWatch device.
- Pairing has failed. You need to restart the device and re-enter the pairing mode.

Unexpected behavior

Reset your SmartWatch by pressing down the power and menu buttons for 4 seconds at the same time. Then press the power button for 3 seconds to restart.
