


POWER SUPPLY FOR UNIT

- Connect the signal cables according to the back panel connection instruction.
- To sure the correct the voltage, insert electronic source cable, turn on the power switch button.
- Use On/Off button to switch power ON/OFF on unit.

BACK PANEL FUNCTION INSTRUCTION

- AUDIO OUTPUT:To connect with this jack, the audio siginal will be played in another speaker
- Switch for power, and switch for LED
- AC input:AC110V/220V

BLUETOOTH MODE

- Short press "Mode" button to switch between Bluetooth connection/Portable storage device/FM / AUX
- On your smartphone, scan and select IQ-8515DJBT "to pair.
- Sound quality will depend on quality of your media file or distance of smartphone from speaker
- To control volume Long Press "VOL-" (volume down) or "VOL+" (volume up).
- To change tracks Short Press " | ◀ | " (Previous Track) or " ▶ | " (Next Track).
- To Pause or Release Pause Short Press " ►II TWS"
- TWS:Press two this model speaker, then long press this button" TWS: Three seconds, it will be in TWS.

PORTABLE STORAGE DEVICE PLAY

- Plug in Portable storage device in the slots provided. Please make sure you use the correct file format in your media devices – MP3 FILES ONLY and correct mode has been selected.
- Short press Mode button to switch between Bluetooth /Portable storage device /FM / AUX. Please ensure that your speaker is fully charged & that your files are MP3 format, or correct source has been selected.
- To control volume Long Press "VOL-" (volume down) or "VOL+" (volume up).
- To change tracks Short Press " I◄◄ " (Previous Track) or " ▶▶ " (Next Track).
- To Pause or Release Pause Short Press " ▶|| "
- Please remember to turn off the power of the Speaker before removing the Portable storage device.

FM RADIO

- Short press "Mode" button to switch between bluetooth / Portable storage device / FM / AUX. And then to press "Play" key to choose FM. Please ensure that your speaker is fully charged & correct source has been selected.
- To control volume Long Press "VOL -" (volume down) or "VOL+" (volume up).
- Short Press" ► | | " to Auto Scan and preset available frequencies
- To switch between preset frequencies Short Press "I ◀ ◀" or "▶ ▶I".

AUX (LINE IN)

- Plug in external device to Aux iack.
- Short press "Mode" button to switch between Bluetooth / Portable storage device /FM / AUX. Please ensure that your speaker is fully charged & correct source has been selected
- To control volume Long Press "VOL-" (volume down) or "VOL+" (volume up).

LIGHT SHOW

• Press the button"FLAMING" on the panel, you can choose the light style as you needed.

It has six kinds of light style for you play. The light can be flash with the music rhythm.

DUAL VOLTAGE

- This model is dual voltage design. AC:110V/220V.
- Factory default:110V
