

# Standalone SAR test exclusion considerations

- Device category =  Portable device  Mobile device
- Transmitting mode =  Single Transmitting  Simultaneous Transmitting
- Max. transmitting frequency = 2480 MHz
- Min. test separation distance = 0 mm
- Max. Antenna Gain = 3.61 dBi
- Max. power with turn-up tolerance = 7.00 dBm = 5.1 mW ( Typical Power = Max. 7.00 dBm )

## KDB 447498 D01 clause 4.3.1 Step 1) SAR test exclusion thresholds for 100MHz to 6GHz at test separation distances $\leq$ 50 mm

[ ( max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW ) / ( min. test separation distance, mm ) ]  $\cdot$  [  $\sqrt{f(\text{GHz})}$  ]  $\leq$  3.0 for 1g SAR and  $\leq$  7.5 for 10g extremity SAR  
 $= [ ( 5.1\text{mW} / 5\text{mm} ) ] \times [ \sqrt{2.48\text{GHz}} ] = 1.6$

Note. The calculation result was rounded to one decimal place for comparison.

→ ***SAR evaluation for general population exposure conditions by measurement or numerical simulation is not required.***
