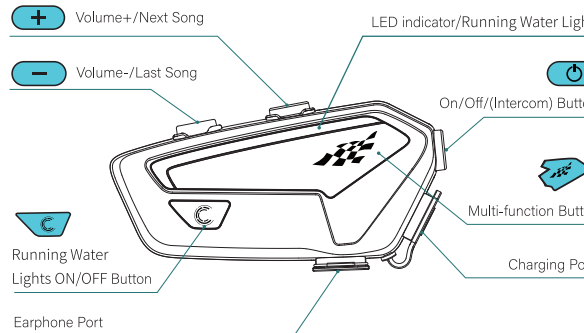


FX HELMET BLUETOOTH INTERCOM QUICK START GUIDE

Product Details



Installation steps

1. Mounting clamp ;
2. Fit the clamp to proper position on the left side of the helmet;
3. Aligning the clamp slot and install FX host on to the clamp;
4. Stick the earphone velcro pads at the ear position inside the helmet;
5. Stick the headphones on Velcro pads;
6. Plug the earphone into the FX earphone jacket

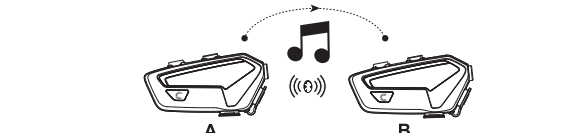
