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


Fig.50. Conducted spurious emission: 8DPSK, Channel 39, 1GHz - 3GHz




Fig.51. Conducted spurious emission: 8DPSK, Channel 39, 3GHz - 10GHz

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


Fig.52. Conducted spurious emission: 8DPSK, Channel 39, 10GHz - 26GHz




Fig.53. Conducted spurious emission: 8DPSK, Channel 78, 2480MHz

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


Fig.54. Conducted spurious emission: 8DPSK, Channel 78, 30MHz - 1GHz




Fig.55. Conducted spurious emission: 8DPSK, Channel 78, 1GHz - 3GHz

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


Fig.56. Conducted spurious emission: 8DPSK, Channel 78, 3GHz - 10GHz




Fig.57. Conducted spurious emission: 8DPSK, Channel 78, 10GHz - 26GHz






Fig.58. Radiated emission (Power): GFSK, low channel




Fig.60. Radiated emission (Power): $\pi/4$ DQPSK, low channel









Fig.61. Radiated emission (Power): π/4 DQPSK, high channel




Fig.63. Radiated emission (Power): 8DPSK, high channel




Fig.64. Time of occupancy (Dwell Time): Channel 39, Packet DH1




Fig.65. Number of Transmissions Measurement: Channel 39, Packet DH1

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


Fig.66. Time of occupancy (Dwell Time): Channel 39, Packet DH3




Fig.67. Number of Transmissions Measurement: Channel 39, Packet DH3

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


Fig.68. Time of occupancy (Dwell Time): Channel 39, Packet DH5




Fig.69. Number of Transmissions Measurement: Channel 39, Packet DH5

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


Fig.70. Time of occupancy (Dwell Time): Channel 39, Packet 2-DH1

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


Fig.72. Time of occupancy (Dwell Time): Channel 39, Packet 2-DH3




Fig.73. Number of Transmissions Measurement: Channel 39, Packet 2-DH3

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


Fig.74. Time of occupancy (Dwell Time): Channel 39, Packet 2-DH5




Fig.75. Number of Transmissions Measurement: Channel 39, Packet 2-DH5

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


Fig.76. Time of occupancy (Dwell Time): Channel 39, Packet 3-DH1




Fig.77. Number of Transmissions Measurement: Channel 39, Packet 3-DH1

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


Fig.78. Time of occupancy (Dwell Time): Channel 39, Packet 3-DH3




Fig.79. Number of Transmissions Measurement: Channel 39, Packet 3-DH3

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


Fig.80. Time of occupancy (Dwell Time): Channel 39, Packet 3-DH5




Fig.81. Number of Transmissions Measurement: Channel 39, Packet 3-DH5

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


Fig.82. 20dB Bandwidth: GFSK, Channel 0




Fig.83. 20dB Bandwidth: GFSK, Channel 39



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


Fig.84. 20dB Bandwidth: GFSK, Channel 78




Fig.85. 20dB Bandwidth: $\pi/4$ DQPSK, Channel 0

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


Fig.86. 20dB Bandwidth: $\pi/4$ DQPSK, Channel 39




Fig.87. 20dB Bandwidth: π/4 DQPSK, Channel 78

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


Fig.88. 20dB Bandwidth: 8DPSK, Channel 0




Fig.89. 20dB Bandwidth: 8DPSK, Channel 39



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


Fig.90. 20dB Bandwidth: 8DPSK, Channel 78

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


Fig.91. Carrier frequency separation measurement: GFSK, Channel 39




Fig.92. Carrier frequency separation measurement: $\pi/4$ DQPSK, Channel 39

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


Fig.93. Carrier frequency separation measurement: 8DPSK, Channel 39

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


Fig.94. Number of hopping frequencies: GFSK, Channel 0 - 39




Fig.95. Number of hopping frequencies: GFSK, Channel 40 - 78

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


Fig.96. Number of hopping frequencies: $\pi/4$ DQPSK, Channel 0 - 39




Fig.97. Number of hopping frequencies: $\pi/4$ DQPSK, Channel 40 - 78

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


Fig.98. Number of hopping frequencies: 8DPSK, Channel 0 - 39




Fig.99. Number of hopping frequencies: 8DPSK, Channel 40 - 78



A.10. AC Powerline Conducted Emission

Method of Measurement: See ANSI C63.10-clause 6.2

1. the one EUT cable configuration and arrangement and mode of operation that produced the emission with the highest amplitude relative to the limit is selected for the final measurement, while applying the appropriate modulating signal to the EUT.

2. If the EUT is relocated from an exploratory test site to a final test site, the highest emissions shall be remaximized at the final test location before final ac power-line conducted emission measurements are performed.

3. The final test on all current-carrying conductors of all of the power cords to the equipment that comprises the EUT (but not the cords associated with other non-EUT equipment in the system) is then performed for the full frequency range for which the EUT is being tested for compliance without further variation of the EUT arrangement, cable positions, or EUT mode of operation.

4. If the EUT is comprised of equipment units that have their own separate ac power connections, e.g., floor-standing equipment with independent power cords for each shelf that are able to connect directly to the ac power network, each current-carrying conductor of one unit is measured while the other units are connected to a second (or more) LISN(s). All units shall be separately measured. If a power strip is provided by the manufacturer, to supply all of the units making up the EUT, only the conductors in the power cord of the power strip shall be measured.

5. If the EUT uses a detachable antenna, these measurements shall be made with a suitable dummy load connected to the antenna output terminals; otherwise, the tests shall be made with the antenna connected and, if adjustable, fully extended. 




