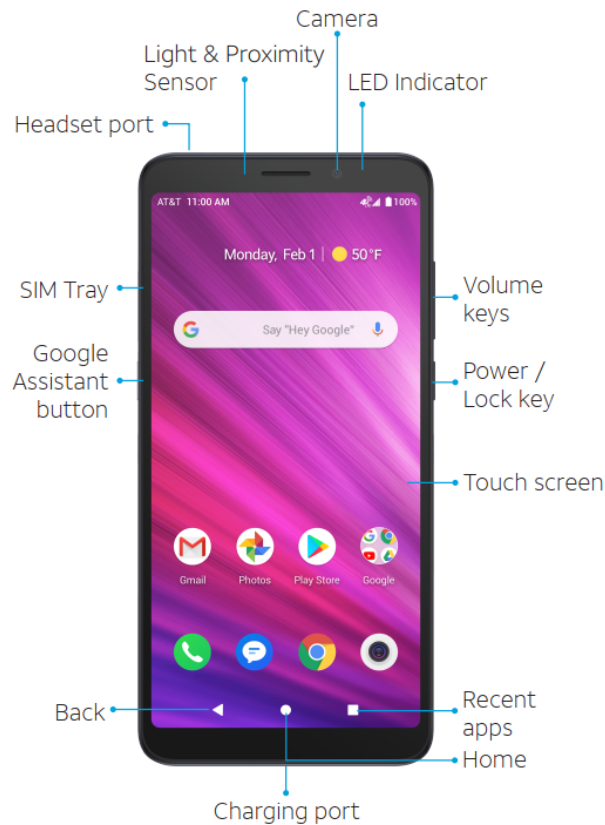

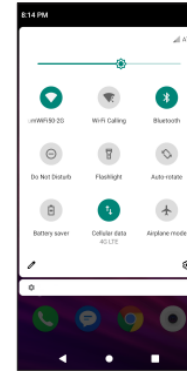

## Easily Adjust Settings

### Quick Settings

1. From the top of the **Home screen**, drag your finger down to view the **Notifications panel**.
2. With the **Notifications panel** open, drag your finger down again to open the **Quick Settings menu**.
3. Tap **Settings**  on the bottom right to access the full Settings menu.







### Secure Your Phone

1. From **Settings**  menu, tap **Security**.
2. Enable your lock/unlock method: Swipe, Pattern, PIN, Password, Fingerprint, or Face Unlock. \*
3. Fingerprint will unlock your phone using fingerprints registered with the sensor on the back of your phone.
4. Face Unlock will unlock your phone using the front camera to register your face.







\* Fingerprint and Facial Recognition methods may not be as secure as Pattern, Pin, or Password locks.

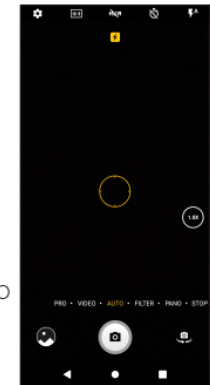
## Capture Life's Moments

### Take a Picture or Record a Video

1. From the **Home screen** > **Camera** :
  - To take a photo: Tap  or press the Volume up/down key.
  - To take a video: From **Camera** > **Video** > **Record**  to start recording. Tap  to stop recording.

### Camera features and settings

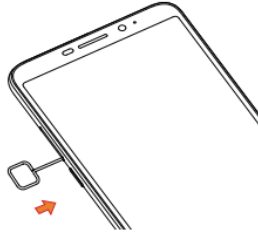
1. To select a different camera mode, tap the options above :
  - Pro: Manually adjust focus, lighting, and more.
  - Video: Shoot and record videos.
  - Auto: Automatically adjust focus, lighting, and more.
  - Filter: Apply real-time filters to your photos.
  - Pano: Capture a horizontally elongated field of view.
  - Stop Motion: Splices frames together.
2. At the top of the camera screen, you can access camera settings , image and video size , HD mode , enable a timer , or enable flash .



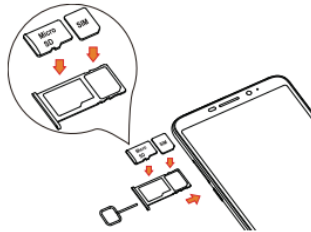
## How to replace the SIM

### Install a SIM/microSD™ Card

1. Use the provided SIM pin to open the SIM tray.



2. Place the SIM card and/or the microSD™\* card in the correct slot as shown.



3. Carefully close the SIM tray.







### Turn on your new phone

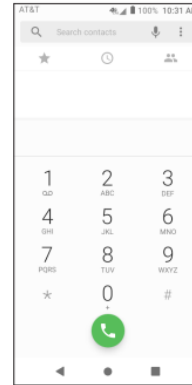
1. Press and hold the Power/Lock key to turn on your phone.

## Call Family & Friends







### Make a Call


1. From the **Home screen** > 
2. Tap **Dialer**  to access the keypad, or select one of the following:
  - Choose frequently called or favorite contacts in **Favorites** .
  - Choose recently called numbers and contacts in **Recents** .
  - Choose a saved contact in **Contacts**, .
3. Tap  to place the call.



### Video Calling



Video Calling lets you make and receive HD Voice calls combined with real-time video.

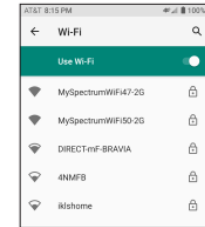
1. From the **Home screen**, tap .
2. Tap **Favorites** , **Recents**  or **Contacts**  to locate the contact, or enter a number in **Dialer** .
3. Tap  next to the contact name or number.

Your phone is equipped with Real-Time Talk (RTT) settings. To enable, go to **Settings**  > **Accessibility** > **RTT Call Button** > **Select visibility preference**.


## Surf & Stream in no time

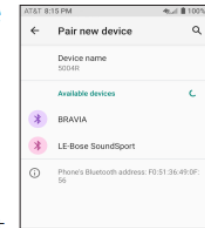
### Connect to Wi-Fi

1. From the **Home screen**, swipe down once.
2. Press and hold **Wi-Fi**  to open the **Wi-Fi menu**.
3. Tap  to turn on **Wi-Fi**.
4. Tap a network name. Enter a password, if required, then tap **Connect**.



### Use Bluetooth

1. From the **Home screen**, swipe down once.
2. Press and hold **Bluetooth**  to open the **Connected Devices menu**.
3. Tap **Pair new device** to turn **Bluetooth** on and display a list of available devices.
4. Tap the name of the device to initiate pairing.
