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









Frequency Response of E-Field (TEM-Cell: ifi110 EXX, Waveguide: R22)



Uncertainty of Frequency Response of E-field: ±7.4% (k=2)














Receiving Pattern (Φ), θ=0°

f=1800 MHz, R22























Conversion Factor Assessment








