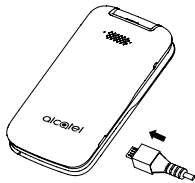

Phone Setup

Charging Battery

Insert the small end of the charging cable into the charge port as shown and connect the charger to a power outlet.



Turning phone on/off

Power on your phone

Press and hold the **End/Power Key** until the phone powers on.

Setup your phone for the first time

The first time you power on the phone, you will be guided through the following steps:

- Select the phone's language, then press the **Right Soft Key** to go to the next step.
- Select an available Wi-Fi network, then press the **Right Soft Key** to go to the next step.
- Learn more about Wi-Fi Calling and then press the **Right Soft Key** to go to the next step.
- Create or sign in to your KaiOS Account if necessary, then press the **Right Soft Key** to go to the next step.
- Read the KaiOS License Terms, then press the **Right Soft Key** to go to the next step.

Even if no SIM card is installed, your phone will still power on and you will be able to connect to a Wi-Fi network and use some of the phone's features.

Power off your phone

Press and hold the **End/Power Key** until the phone displays: **Lock, Clean Up Memory, Restart, and Power off**. Use the **Navigation Key** to select **Power off**, then press the **Center Soft Key**.

Set up your KaiOS Account

To create a KaiOS account. Go to **Settings > Account > KaiOS Account**.

Press to create a new account or sign in to an existing account.

Use Your Google Assistant

Need to get something done? Just press a button and ask!

Launch your Google Assistant

1. From the Home screen, press and hold the **Center Soft Key** to launch your **Google Assistant**, or press the **Navigate Left Key** to access your **Google Assistant**.
2. Once the "Listening..." screen appears, say your voice command out loud. Your **Google Assistant** will speak back to you and walk you through the next steps.

Use Google Assistant to Make a Call

- **Call a contact:** Press and hold the **Center Soft Key**, then say "Call Katie." Your phone will call Katie from your Contacts.
- **Call a number:** Press and hold the **Center Soft Key**, then say "Call 998-321-1234." Your phone will dial the number.

What else can your Google Assistant do?

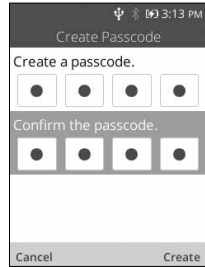
- Open an app: "Open E-Mail."
- Get the weather: "What's the weather in Miami today?"
- Send a text: "Send a text to Katie."
- Find a local business: "Find a pizza place."
- Find out what else your Google Assistant can do: "What can you do?"

Security Settings

Lock/Unlock your screen

To protect your phone and privacy, you can lock the phone screen by creating a passcode.

- From the Home screen, press the **Center Soft Key**, select **Settings**, and then press the **Navigation Key** to select **Privacy & Security**.
- Press the **Center Soft Key** and select **On** to enable screen lock in the **Screen Lock** screen.
- Enter the passcode twice and press the **Right Soft Key** to create.



SIM Security

A SIM PIN prevents access to the SIM card cellular data networks. When it's enabled, any device containing the SIM card will request the PIN upon restart. A SIM PIN is not the same as the lock code used to unlock the device.

Anti-Theft

Anti-theft can only be enabled after logging in to your KaiOS Account.

Calls

Make a call

- Dial the desired number then press the **Call Key** to make the call. Press the **End/Power Key** to delete the incorrect digits. Press the **Right Soft Key** to display more **Options**.
- **Make a call from your call log:** Press the **Call Key** from the Home screen to access the call log and choose the contact you want to dial, press the **Center Soft Key** to make the call.
- **Make a call from Contacts:** Select **Contacts** from the app list. Choose the contact you want to dial, press the **Center Soft Key** twice or the **Call Key** to make the call.
- **Making an emergency call:** If your phone has network coverage, dial emergency number and press the **Call Key** to make an emergency call. This works even without a SIM card and without typing the PIN code.
- **Make an international call:** To dial an international call, press key twice to enter "+", then enter the international country prefix followed by the full phone number and then press the **Call Key**.

Answering or rejecting a call

When you receive a call:

- Press the **Left Soft Key** or the **Call Key** to answer;
- Press the **Right Soft Key** or the **End/Power Key** to reject;
- To mute the ringtone volume of an incoming call, press the **Volume Up/Down Key**.

Tip: If the device is closed, you will get a preview of an incoming call on the external screen. You can accept the call by flipping the device open and you can begin talking immediately.

Calling your voicemail ⁽¹⁾

Press and hold key to call and listen to your voicemail.

⁽¹⁾ Contact your network operator to check service availability.

Contacts

View Contacts

Contacts enables quick and easy access to the contact you want to reach.

- Press the **Center Soft Key** from the Home screen and select **Contacts**.
- Press the **Left Soft Key** in the contact list to create a new contact.
- Press the **Center Soft Key** to access contact details.
- Press the **Right Soft Key** to access more options.

Adding a Contact

On the contacts list screen, press the **Left Soft Key** to access **New Contact** and input the contact information.

When finished, press the **Center Soft Key** to save.

Editing a Contact

On the contacts list screen, press the **Right Soft Key** to access **Options**, select **Edit contact** and press the **Center Soft Key** to edit. When finished, press the **Center Soft Key** to save.

Deleting a Contact

On the contacts list screen, press the **Right Soft Key** to access **Options**, select **Delete contacts**, press the **Navigation Key** and the **Center Soft Key** to select, and then press the **Right Soft Key** to delete.

Sharing a Contact

You can share a single contact with others by sending the contact's vCard to them via Email, Messages, or Bluetooth.

Select a contact you want to share, press the **Right Soft Key** to access **Options**, and then select **Share**.

Import/Export Contacts

On the contacts list screen, press the **Right Soft Key** to access **Options**, select **Settings > Import contacts/Export contacts** to import/export contacts from/to memory card, Gmail, Outlook, or Bluetooth.

Messages

Use the messaging feature to send and receive text (SMS) and multimedia (MMS) messages.

Sending a Text Message

- From the Home screen, press the **Center Soft Key** and select **Messages**.
- Press the **Left Soft Key** to write a new message.
- Enter the phone number of the recipient in the **To** bar or press the **Right Soft Key** to add recipients.
- Press the **Navigation Key** to go to the **SMS** bar to enter the text of the message.
- Press the **Left Soft Key** to send text messages.

Sending a Multimedia Message

MMS enables you to send video clips, images, photos, contacts and sounds to other compatible phones and email addresses by pressing the **Right Soft Key** from the text messages screen and then selecting **Add attachment**.

An SMS will be converted to MMS automatically when media files (image, video, audio, etc.) are attached or email addresses are added.

Tip: An SMS of more than 160 characters will be charged as several SMS. Specific letters (accent) will also increase the size of the SMS. This may cause multiple SMS to be sent to your recipient.

Using Navigation key

Navigation key is located above the number pad that frames the **Center Soft Key**.

Shortcuts accessible from the Home screen:

- **Navigate up:** Access Quick Settings, such as Camera, Bluetooth, Wi-Fi, and more.
- **Navigate down:** Access Camera and quickly capture photos and videos.
- **Navigate left:** Access the Apps on the Home screen (Store, your Google Assistant, Google Maps, and YouTube).
- **Navigate right:** Access Messages and quickly send and read text messages.
- **Center Soft Key:** Access the App tray. Press and hold the **Center Soft Key** to launch your Google Assistant.

Getting connected

To connect to the Internet with this phone, you can use GPRS/EDGE/3G/LTE networks or Wi-Fi, whichever is most convenient.

Connecting to the Internet

- **Network connection:** The first time you turn on your phone with your SIM card inserted, it will automatically configure your network service. To check the network connection you are using, press **Settings > Network & Connectivity > Mobile network & Data**, and press **Carrier > Network Type**.
- **Data Connection:** If you do not need to transmit data on mobile networks, turn off data connection to avoid incurring significant charges for data use on local operator mobile networks, particularly if you do not have a mobile data agreement. Press **Settings > Network & Connectivity > Mobile network & Data > Data Connection**, select **On/Off** to enable/disable data connection.

Wi-Fi

Using Wi-Fi, you can connect to the Internet when your phone is within range of a wireless network. Wi-Fi can be used on your phone even without a SIM card inserted.

- Press **Settings > Network & Connectivity > Wi-Fi**.
- Select **On/Off** to turn Wi-Fi on/off.
- The detailed information for detected Wi-Fi networks is displayed in the **Available Networks** section.
- Select a Wi-Fi network to connect. If the network you selected is secured, you will need to enter a password or other credentials (you can contact the network operator for details). When finished, press the **Right Soft Key** to connect.

Connecting to a computer

With the USB cable, you can transfer media files and other files between your phone's internal storage and the computer.

- Enable **USB storage** in **Settings > Storage > USB storage**.
- Use the micro-USB connector to connect your phone to your computer.
- Use your computer's operating system to find your phone to access files or SD card.

This phone is compatible with Windows® XP, Windows® 7, Windows® Vista, Windows® 8, Windows® 10, Linux and Mac OS®.

Use Bluetooth®

1. From the Home screen, press the **Center Soft Key** > **Settings** > **Network & Connectivity > Bluetooth**.
2. Press the **Center Soft Key** to choose On or Off.
3. Press the **Navigation Key** to go to **Nearby Devices** > press the **Center Soft Key** to select your preferred Bluetooth device.
4. Press the **Navigation Key** to go to the name of the device to pair > press the **Center Soft Key**.

Status bar

From the status bar, you can view both phone status (to the right side) and notification information (to the left side).
