MODES

Turn the Action Camera ON and repeatedly press the Power/Mode Button to cycle through the camera mode settings, they will appear in this order: Video, Playback, and Settings.







RECORDING VIDEO

Power on the camera and verify you're in Video Mode. Press the Shutter/OK Button. A "beep" will sound and the Camera Light Indicator will flash while recording. Press the Shutter/OK Button to stop, a beep will sound and the lights will shut off. In the event your camera is low on battery, it will automatically save your video before the battery dies and shuts itself off.

PHOTO MODE

Verify you're in Photo Mode (Note: the Photo icon will show on the screen). To take a photo, press the Shutter/Select Button. A camera shutter noise will sound.

VIDEO LAPSE
