To Whom It May Concern,

This is to report a Class II Permissive Change to Bluetooth Low Energy Button under FCC ID: 2ACR9-FLIC, Model: Flic. This product was originally granted on November 11, 2015.

The changes are under new model name: Powered by Flic

“Powered by Flic” is using identical RF circuitry, Layout, parts list & firmware to original model Flic. The only changes are not RF related:

- a. “Powered by Flic” has different product outlooks from Flic.
- b. “Powered by Flic” contains a larger battery CR2032, to give longer battery life as compared to Flic which is using CR2016.
- c. “Powered by Flic” does not have replaceable battery as compared to Flic.


Therefore, the product documents on file with FCC from the original grant/certification of FCC ID: 2ACR9-FLIC, remain unchanged and continue to be valid for “Powered by Flic”, except the following documents to be filled with FCC by this Class II Permissive Change:

1. Label and location for “Powered by Flic”
2. External & internal photos for “Powered by Flic”
3. User manual for “Powered by Flic”
