### To view the result of inspection

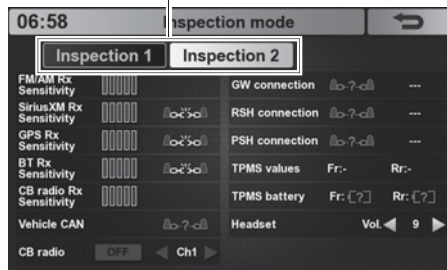
The unit performs internal inspection itself, and allows you to view the result of inspection.

To view the result of inspection, proceed as follows.

1. On the HOME screen, touch .
2. On the [Menu] screen, touch [Settings].
3. On the [General] setting menu, touch  three times to display the succeeding items, and touch [Inspection mode].

The [Inspection mode] screen appears.

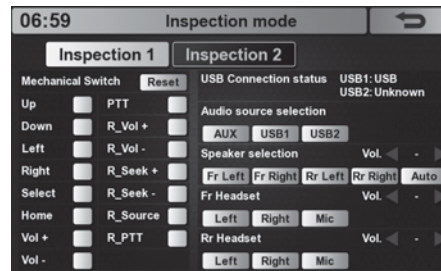

To view the [Inspection 1] screen / [Inspection 2] screen

Touch either [Inspection 1] or [Inspection 2], and the selected screen appears.

Following is an example of [Inspection 2] screen.



How to read the [Inspection 1] screen

- [FM/AM Rx Sensitivity]  
Indicates the FM and AM broadcast reception status.
-   
The better the reception status, the more the bars turn on.
- [SiriusXM Rx Sensitivity]  
Indicates the SiriusXM reception status.



The better the reception status, the more the bars turn on.



Indicates that the unit is receiving SiriusXM.



Indicates that the unit is not receiving SiriusXM.



Indicates that the status of SiriusXM reception is not clear.

- [GPS Rx Sensitivity]  
Indicates the GPS signal reception status.



The better the reception status, the more the bars turn on.

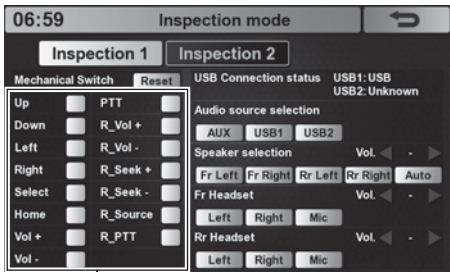

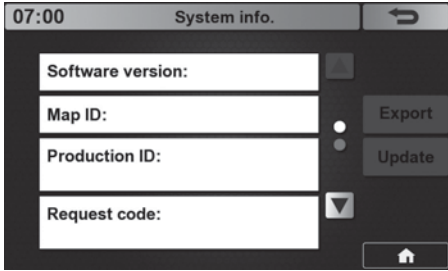


Hardware button indicators

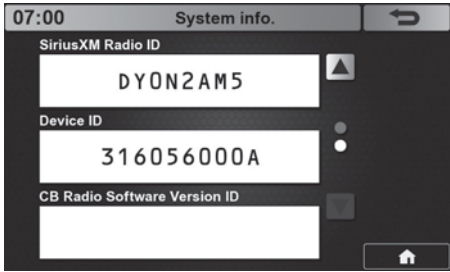

## SETTINGS

### Communication settings

Use the [Communi.] setting menu to make the communication-related settings, such as the settings for Bluetooth, the settings for phone communication, etc.

#### To make settings for Bluetooth

1. On the HOME screen, touch .
2. On the [Menu] screen, touch [Settings].
3. On the category selection tab, touch  or  and then touch [Communi.].

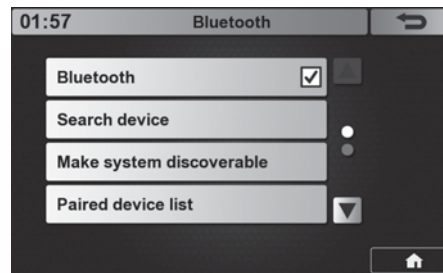
The [Communi.] setting menu appears.



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4. On the [Communi.] setting menu, touch [Bluetooth].

The [Bluetooth] screen appears.



#### To turn on/off the Bluetooth communication

To use a Bluetooth device such as a smartphone with the unit, you must first turn on the Bluetooth communication of the unit.

On the [Bluetooth] screen, touch [Bluetooth] so that a checkmark is added, and the Bluetooth communication is turned on.

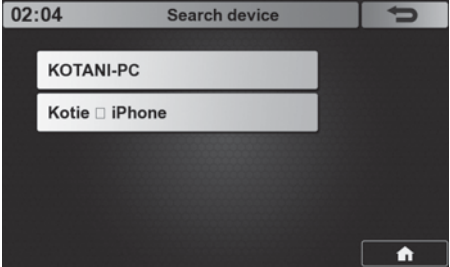
To turn it off, touch [Bluetooth] again so that the checkmark is removed.

#### To search for a Bluetooth device and establish connection with the device (pairing)

The unit allows you to search for a nearby Bluetooth device such as a smartphone, view the detected Bluetooth device name, and establish connection with the Bluetooth device.

Proceed as follows.

- 1. On the [Bluetooth] screen, touch [Search device].  
If a Bluetooth device is detected, its name will be displayed, as shown in the following example.



- 2. Touch the Bluetooth device name.  
A confirmation window like the following appears.



- 3. Touch [Pair].  
If a message appears on the Bluetooth device that prompts you to confirm pairing, operate as requested.  
To cancel pairing, touch [Don't Pair].

When connection with the Bluetooth device is successfully established, the [Paired device list] screen appears.



On the [Paired device list] screen, you can confirm the available functions of the paired Bluetooth device.

The following icons indicate that the corresponding function is available when the figure is lit blue.

- [Phone icon] : Hands-free phone
- [Music icon] : Music playback
- [Globe icon] : Roaming?????????

When the figure is turned black, the corresponding function is not available.  
Note that only functions provided with the Bluetooth device can be set available.

**TIP** \_\_\_\_\_  
Up to eight Bluetooth devices can be paired with the unit.

## SETTINGS

To make a Bluetooth device search for the unit and establish connection with the unit

1. On the [Bluetooth] screen, touch [Make system discoverable].

The following confirmation window appears.



The unit now allows the Bluetooth device to detect it.

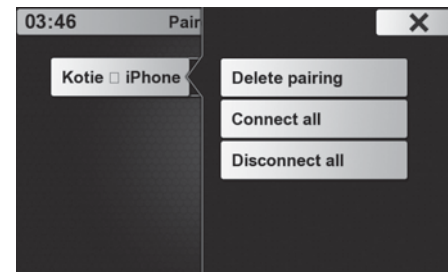
2. Operate the Bluetooth device to search for another Bluetooth device, and when the unit is detected under the name "yamaha", continue operation to establish connection with the unit within the indicated time.

Touch [Cancel] to stop operation.

To show the [Paired device list] screen

On the [Bluetooth] screen, touch [Paired device list].

When you touch a paired Bluetooth device name, the screen changes as follows.



To cancel pairing with the Bluetooth device, touch [Delete pairing].

To make functions of the Bluetooth device (hands-free phone/music playback/roaming?????) available, touch [Connect all].

To make functions of the Bluetooth device unavailable, touch [Disconnect all].

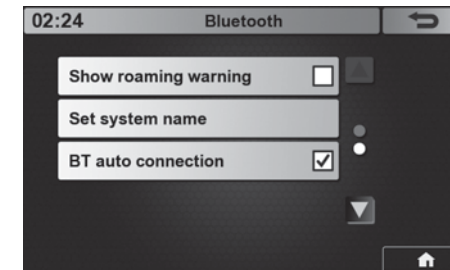
To turn on/off the roaming warning

When a paired Bluetooth device sends a roaming warning message, the unit allows you to view it on the screen.

To view the warning message, turn on the roaming warning.

Proceed as follows.

1. On the [Bluetooth] screen, touch ▼ to display the succeeding items.



2. Touch [Show roaming warning] so that a checkmark is added.

To turn off the roaming warning, touch [Show roaming warning] again so that the checkmark is removed.

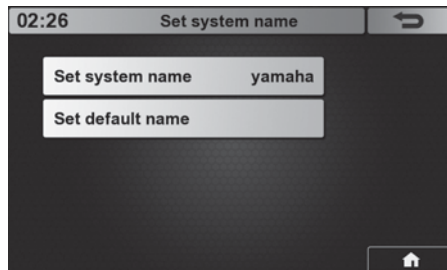
### To change the unit's name as a Bluetooth device

At the time of purchase, the unit has a name "yamaha" as a Bluetooth device. When a Bluetooth device detects the unit, the unit is recognised as "yamaha".

To change the name, proceed as follows.

1. On the [Bluetooth] screen, touch ▼ to display the succeeding items.
2. Touch [Set system name].

The [Set system name] screen appears.



3. Touch [Set system name].
4. By using the software keyboard that appears, enter a desired name, and touch [Enter].

To reset the name to "yamaha", touch [Set default name] on the [Set system name] screen.

### To establish connection with an already paired Bluetooth device

The unit allows you to automatically establish connection with an already paired Bluetooth device when you turn the ignition on.

To enable this function, proceed as follows.

1. On the [Bluetooth] screen, touch ▼ to display the succeeding items.
2. Touch [BT auto connection] so that a checkmark is added.

To disable this function, touch [BT auto connection] again so that the checkmark is removed.

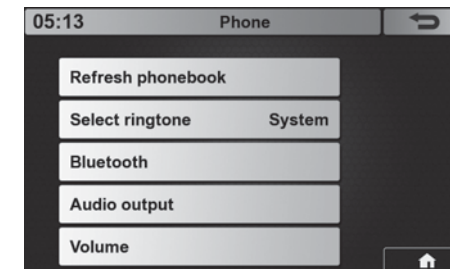
### **To make settings for phone communication**

1. On the HOME screen, touch ☰.
2. On the [Menu] screen, touch [Settings].
3. On the category selection tab, touch ◀ or ▶ and then touch [Communi.].

The [Communi.] setting menu appears.

4. On the [Communi.] setting menu, touch [Phone].

The [Phone] screen appears.

### To clear the phonebook

On the [Phone] screen, touch [Refresh phonebook].

The entire content of the existing phonebook will be cleared.

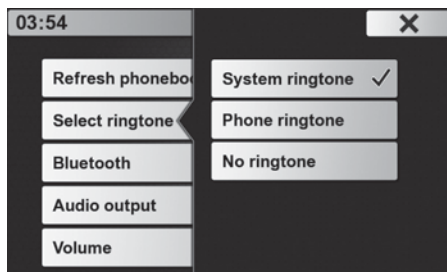
### To select a ringtone

You can select the type of ringtone that is heard from the headset.

The screen changes as follows.



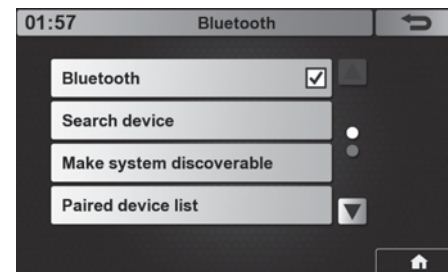
2. To use the unit's ringtone, touch [System ringtone].

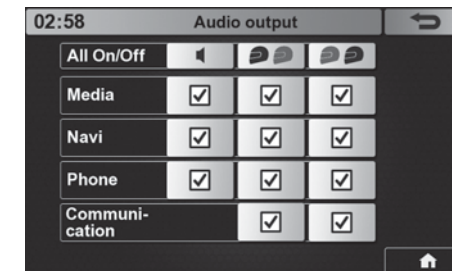

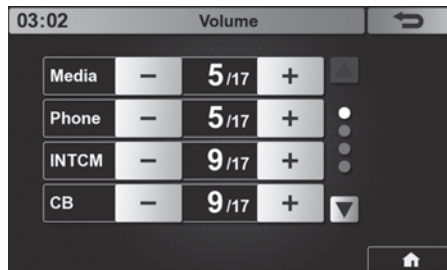

3. Touch .
4. Touch [Volume].

### **To make settings for voice communication**

You can adjust the microphone sensitivity of rider’s headset and passenger’s headset.

1. On the HOME screen, touch .
2. On the [Menu] screen, touch [Settings].
3. On the category selection tab, touch or and then touch [Communi.].

The [Communi.] setting menu appears.

4. On the [Communi.] setting menu, touch [Vox].

The [Vox] screen appears.



### To adjust the microphone sensitivity of rider’s headset

1. On the [Vox] screen, touch [Vox for rider headset] so that a checkmark is added.

This enables adjustment of the microphone sensitivity of rider’s headset.

2. Touch or to change the microphone sensitivity of the rider’s headset.

The adjustable range is from 0/17 to 17/17.

To disable adjustment, touch [Vox for rider headset] again so that the checkmark is removed.

### To adjust the microphone sensitivity of passenger’s headset

1. On the [Vox] screen, touch [Vox for passenger headset] so that a checkmark is added.

This enables adjustment of the microphone sensitivity of passenger’s headset.

2. Touch **+** or **-** to change the microphone sensitivity of the passenger's headset.

To disable adjustment, touch [Vox for passenger headset] again so that the checkmark is removed.

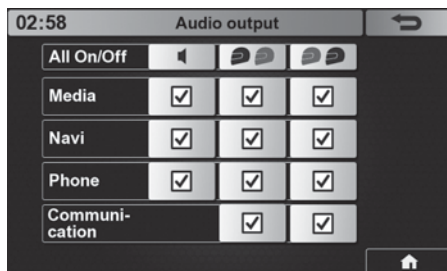
### TIP

When the sensitivity level is set to 0, voices of the rider/passenger will not be picked up by the microphone.

### To turn on/off the sound

1. On the [Vox] screen, touch **▼** to display the succeeding items.
2. Touch [Audio output].

The [Audio output] screen appears.

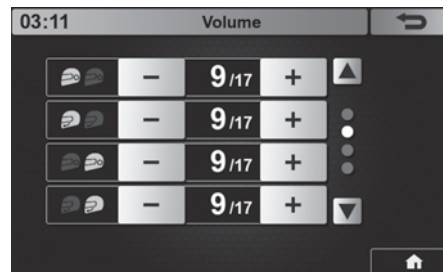

You can either activate or deactivate the hardware buttons on the vehicle operable by a passenger.

1. On the HOME screen, touch .
2. On the [Menu] screen, touch [Settings].
3. On the category selection tab, touch  or  and then touch [Communi.].

The [Communi.] setting menu appears.



4. To activate the hardware buttons operable by a passenger, touch [Rear controller] so that a checkmark is added.




To deactivate, touch [Rear con-

troller] again so that the checkmark is removed.


### To select the speaker system to be used

The front speaker system of the vehicle is always enabled.

You can enable or disable the rear speaker system.

1. On the HOME screen, touch .
2. On the [Menu] screen, touch [Settings].
3. On the category selection tab, touch  or  and then touch [Communi.].

The [Communi.] setting menu appears.

4. Touch  to display the succeeding items.






5. To enable the rear speaker system, touch [2 zone audio] so that a checkmark is added.

To disable the rear speaker system, touch [2 zone audio] again so that the check mark is removed.

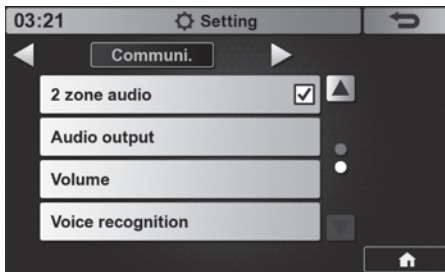

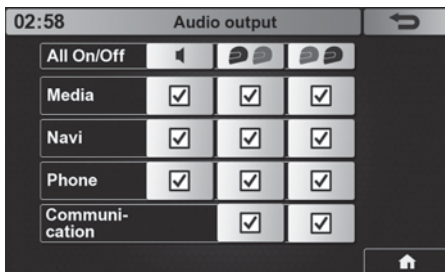

Explanations for each icon and term are given below.

[Media]: Sounds of radio broadcasts and audio devices you can play back by touching  on the HOME screen.

[Navi]: Sounds and voices heard during route guidance. Available only when the navigation function is activated.




[Phone]: Sounds and voices heard during hands-free phone communication.

[Communication]: Voice communication between rider and passenger.

 : Indicates external speakers.




 : Indicates rider's headset.

 : Indicates passenger's headset.


You can turn on/off the sound of [Media], [Navi], [Phone] (and [Communication]) all at once by touching , , and .

### To make settings for the voice recognition function

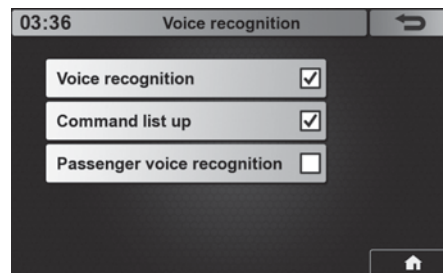

### To allow passenger to use the voice recognition function

On the [Voice recognition] screen, touch [Passenger voice recognition] so that a checkmark is added.




To make the voice recognition function unavailable for a passenger, touch [Passenger voice recognition] again so that the checkmark is removed.



## Audio settings


Use the [Audio] settings menu to make the audio-related settings, such as the bass/treble/fader/SVC adjustment. The [Audio] settings menu also allows you to make settings for Bluetooth.

### To adjust bass/treble/fader/SVC

1. On the HOME screen, touch .
2. On the [Menu] screen, touch [Settings].
3. On the category selection tab, touch  or  and then touch [Audio].  
The [Audio] setting menu appears.





On this screen, you can adjust bass, treble and fader.

4. To adjust SVC, touch  to display the succeeding items.



### How to adjust bass/treble



To increase bass/treble, touch  under [Bass]/[Treble].  
To decrease bass/treble, touch .

### How to adjust fader

To decrease the sound volume of the rear speaker system, touch [Front].  
To decrease the sound volume of the front speaker system, touch [Rear].

### How to adjust SVC

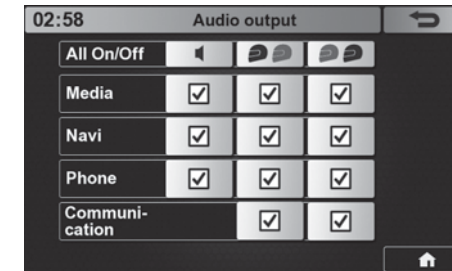

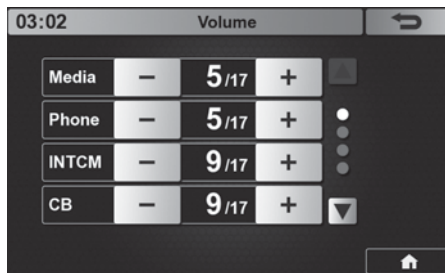

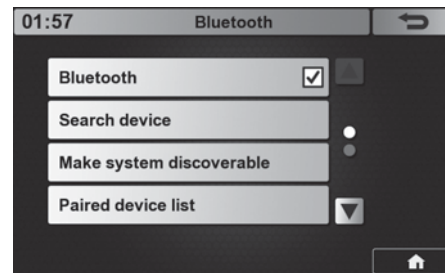

2. On the [Menu] screen, touch [Settings].
3. On the category selection tab, touch  or  and then touch [Audio].

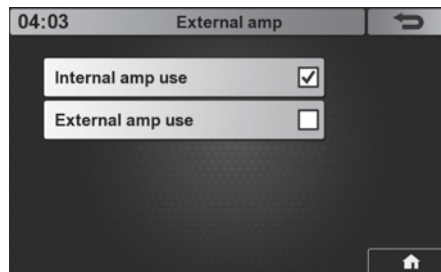
The [Audio] setting menu appears.

4. On the [Audio] setting menu, touch  twice to display the succeeding items.



5. Touch [External amp].

The [External amp] screen appears.



6. To use the internal amplifier, touch [Internal amp use] so that a checkmark is added.

To use the external amplifier, touch [External amp use] so that a checkmark is added.

You can add checkmarks for both [Internal amp use] and [External amp use].

If you do not want to use a specific amplifier, touch again so that the checkmark is removed.

## Navigation mode settings

### TIP

The navigation mode settings can be made only when the navigation function is activated.

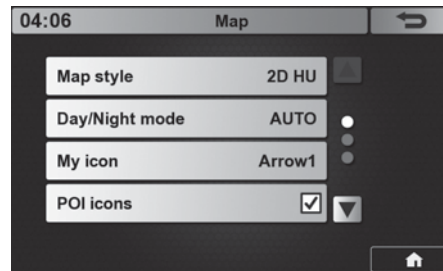
Use the [Navigation] setting menu to make the various types of navigation-related settings.

### To select the map display mode

1. On the HOME screen, touch .
2. On the [Menu] screen, touch [Settings].
3. On the category selection tab, touch  or  and then touch [Navigation].  
The [Navigation] setting menu appears.



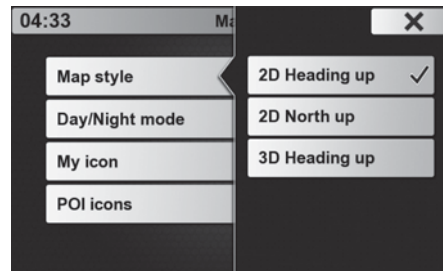
4. Touch [Map].  
The [Map] screen appears.



### To select the map style

On the [Map] screen, touch [Map style].

The screen changes as follows.



To select the 2D heading up map, touch [2D Heading up].

2-dimensional map will be displayed with the running direction always on the upper side.

To select the 2D north up map, touch [2D North up].

2-dimensional map will be displayed with the north direction always on the upper side.

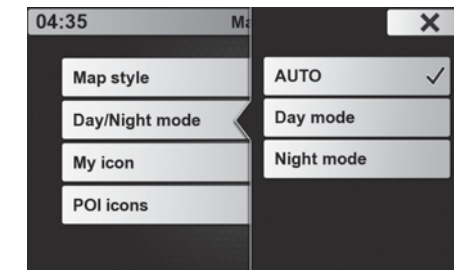
To select the 3D heading up map, touch [3D Heading up].

3-dimensional map will be displayed with the running direction always on the upper side.

### To switch the day mode/night mode

On the [Map] screen, touch [Day/Night mode].

The screen changes as follows.

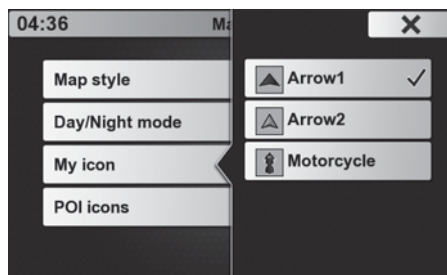
If you want the screen to always be in the daytime display, touch [Day mode].

If you want the screen to always be in the nighttime display, touch [Night mode].

Touch [AUTO] so that the screen switches between the daytime display and the nighttime display automatically according to the ambient lightness.

### To change the shape of the “current location” icon

On the [Map] screen, touch [My icon]. The screen changes as follows.



Touch the desired icon that indicates the current location (your own vehicle position) on the map, by referring to the shape of the icons shown on the screen.

### To enable/disable display of the POI (Point Of Interest) icons

On the [Map] screen, touch [POI icons] so that a checkmark is added.

POI icons will be viewed on the map.

Touch [POI icons] again so that the checkmark is removed.

POI icons will not be viewed on the map.

For how to determine the POI icons to be displayed on the map, see “To show/hide the POI icons” on page @-@@.

### To activate/deactivate the intersection zoom function

On the [Map] screen, touch ▼ to display the succeeding items, and then touch [Intersection zoom] so that a checkmark is added.

Intersections will be zoomed up on the map.

Touch [Intersection zoom] again so that the checkmark is removed, and the intersection zoom function is deactivated.

### To enable/disable the speed limit indication

On the [Map] screen, touch ▼ to display the succeeding items, and then touch [Speed limit indication] so that a checkmark is added.

A speed limit will be displayed as in the following example.



Touch [Speed limit indication] again so that the checkmark is removed, and a speed limit will not be displayed.

### To show/hide the lane guidance

On the [Map] screen, touch ▼ to display the succeeding items, and then touch [Lane guidance] so that a checkmark is added.

Lane guidance indication will be displayed on the map, as in the following example.



Touch [Lane guidance] again so that the checkmark is removed, and the lane guidance indication will not be displayed.

### To show/hide the signpost display

On the [Map] screen, touch ▼ to display the succeeding items, and then touch [Signpost] so that a checkmark is added.

Touch [Signpost] again so that the checkmark is removed, and signposts will not be displayed.

### To activate/deactivate the logbook function

On the [Map] screen, touch ▼ twice to display the succeeding items, and then touch [Record] so that a checkmark is added.

In this state, the guided route information will be recorded in the logbook.

Touch [Record] again so that the checkmark is removed, and the logbook function will be deactivated.

### **To show/hide the POI icons**

You can specify the POI (Point Of Interest) icons to be displayed on the map.

1. On the HOME screen, touch ☰.
2. On the [Menu] screen, touch [Settings].

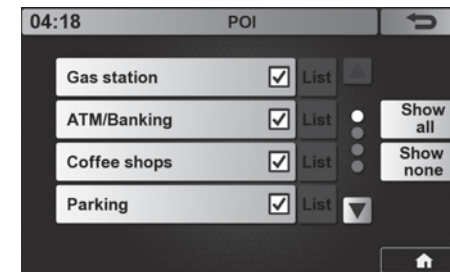
3. On the category selection tab, touch ◀ or ▶ and then touch [Navigation].

The [Navigation] setting menu appears.



4. Touch [POI].
