# Faceplate on the headunit

1	POWER/VOL	Use to adjust the power ON / OFF or volume of the product.  To make the AV OFF state, press POWER/VOL knob in the power on state.  To make the AV ON state, press POWER/VOL knob in the AV OFF.  To make the Power OFF state, Long press in the POWER ON state.  To make the POWER ON state, press POWER/VOL knob in the power OFF.  To adjust volume, turn POWER/VOL left or right.
2	RADIO	Switch to the radio application.  Toggled the radio each band is activated whenever pressing the button.  > Toggled Order  FM > AM > DMB
3	MEDIA	Switch to available media application. 


