Pursuant to CFR Title 47 Telecommunication Federal Communications Comission§0.457(d) and §0.459 and IC RSP-100, Section 6.4, Cambridge Communication Systems Ltd requests that parts of the FCC application be held confidential.

The Mesh V2 is a 60 GHz mmW fixed wireless product which will be able to deliver Gigabit performance broadband services to markets such as rural areas.

Cambridge Communication Systems Ltd\_has spent substantial time and effort in developing the Metnet 60G Mesh V2 which is one of the first of its kind in the industry. The product will not be available to the public but only to Cambridge Communication Systems partners and affiliates under NDA.

Having the sensitive design information being easily available to "competition" would negate the advantage we have achieved by developing this product. By not protecting the details of the Metnet 60G Mesh V2 design will result in the financial hardship of the business which in turn would inhibit the development of new broadband services which are currently being sought in the USA.
