G=power gain of the antenna in the direction of interest relative to an isotropic radiator

R=distance to the center of radiation of the antenna

From the peak EUT RF output power, the minimum mobile separation distance, d=0.2m, as well as the gain of the used antenna is -1.0 dBi, the RF power density can be obtained.
