MICROPHONE + VOLUME/ MEDIA CONTROLLER OVERVIEW

1. Power on/ off. Phone answer -call button.
2. Long press for next song, short press for raise volume.
3. Long press for previous song, short press for lower volume.
4. Microphone.
5. Bluetooth LED indicator.
6. USB charging port
7. Charging LED indicator



CHARGING DEVICE

- This Bluetooth earbud has 270mAh rechargeable batteries. To charge earbud, follow steps below.
1. Insert USB end of micro cable, included, into computer USB port.
 2. Connect micro end of cable into the media controllers micro port.
 3. Red indicator light is ON when battery is charging.
 4. Blue indicator light is ON when battery is fully charged.
 5. Battery is fully charged in about 2 hours.
 6. ways to recharge: Wall outlet, car, computer.

OPERATING DEVICE

A. Power On&Pairing/Power Off

Power On&Pairing:

1. First time use the earphone,hold press MFB button 4 second,you will listening "power on \pairing(Red and blue light will alternate flash at the same time) When you release the MFB button.find the "DEWALT Earphone 2091" on the bluetooth device list. and choose it you will listening "your devices connected"your earphone and device are connected
2. successful .When you use the earphone to connect with your device again,just need hold press,MFB button for 2 second.listening "power on "(it will red light),release the MFB button,earphone connect with bluetooth.device self-motion
