To Whom It May Concern:

The Coca-Cola Company hereby declares that the radio frequency identification (RFID) reader, model PCA-1143-A03 submitted as FCC ID: 2ADIR-XQ4-FS-RFID meets the following FCC requirements of CFR Title 47 Part 15.247(a)(1):

- The hopping sequence is pseudorandom.
- All channels are used equally on average.
- The receiver input bandwidth approximately equals the transmit bandwidth.
- The receiver hop is in sequence with the transmit signal.

Furthermore, it also meets FCC requirement of Section 15.247(h):

The system does not coordinate its channel selection/hopping sequence with other frequency hopping systems for the express purpose of avoiding the simultaneous occupancy of individual hopping frequencies by multiple transmitters
