



The LED indicator will turn RED while charging and turn OFF when fully charged.



- Bluetooth Pairing

 1. Power the speaker ON. "Power On" will be heard and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode. The LED indicator will flash RED & BLUE.

 2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select "LOMM1082" from the list of found devices.

 3. After a successful pairing, "Connected" will be heard, and the LED indicator will slowly flash BLUE.

 The speaker will automatically pair with previously connected mobile devices that are within range.

 The speaker will automatically power OFF after 3 minutes if not paired with a device.
