Use Precautions:

PT-01 transmitter

- Do not open or modify the main unit case.
- Do not touch the contact portions of the Alkaline. Failure to observe the may cause poor contact.
- Remove the isolation film from the PT-01 before using.

Operation environment and service place

- Keep the device away from high temperature or excessive dust.
- Do not put this device where static is likely to be generated or where magnetism generating devices as TV set and radio are nearby.
- Do not leave this product under direct sunshine or at excessive high or low temperatures of long time.

How to maintain the device:

- Use a dry soft cloth to remove dirt from this product. When stubborn stains are observed, use a tightly twisted water soaked cloth to wipe the point softly and use dry another cloth to wipe the point again.
- Do not use thinner, benzene, wax, kerosene, polish, hot water, chemical cloth and the like.
- The dirty connector may cause charging failure.







No	Name	Details
1	Indicator	Light Blue: Transmitter mode Blink Blue: Low battery.
2	Transmitter ID	Transmitter ID number
3	Press button	Press the button to send a message or signal

1. Remove the battery isolation film before using (as below)




2. Taping white sticker on the designated area



Installations


■ PT-01 transmitter installations:

1. Place the PT-01 on the table.




2. Mounted on the table.(Option)

Step 1. Fix the Holder on the table with double sided tape or two self-tapping screws




Step 2. Slide the PT-01 into the bracket.




Dismount:

1. Remove the PT-01 from the Holder




Replace a Battery Pack

- How to replace Alkaline battery
- **1.** Screwed the back cover of the PT-01 Transmitter




2. Take out the Alkaline battery




3. Replace a new Alkaline battery

When inserting the Alkaline battery into the unit, make sure that the terminals are correctly directed.



4. Close the back cover of PT-01
