




**Batteries Installation** 




To install batteries into the Remote Control Mist Spraying Dragon, unscrew the screw on the battery box cover to open the battery compartment. Insert 3 x "AA" 1.5V batteries (Not Included) into the battery box. Batteries should be placed as shown on the diagram.

Put back in place the battery box cover and tighten the screw.
