DO NOT USE Quick-Charging USB Adapter to charge the product, as it might damage the product.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Use the Micro USB charging cable. (Not Included) Connect the Micro USB plug to Micro USB charging port on the Wall Climber RC Venom Car, then connect the USB plug to a USB port on a computer or wall adapter to begin charging. The LED Indicator will turn red while charging and will turn off once fully charged. <p>NOTE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You must select a qualified charger from a regular manufacturer. You must charge the Wall Climber RC Venom Car if it has been not used for more than 6 months. 
<p>Batteries Installation For Remote Controller</p>  <p>To install batteries into the Remote Controller, unscrew the screw on the battery box cover to open the cover. Insert 2(Two) X AAA 1.5V Alkaline Batteries (Not Included) into the battery box. Batteries should be placed as shown on the diagram.
