<p>4.2. Pairing to Mobile phone or other device</p> <p>To use your Bluetooth headset, you must first pair your headset with a mobile phone or other Bluetooth device. Once your Bluetooth headset is paired to a specific mobile phone, they will remain paired and automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range.</p> <p>Pairing to a phone and Entertainment:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Turn on your phone and ensure the Bluetooth function is activated. Turn on the headset, enter the Bluetooth pairing mode. Search your Bluetooth devices on your phone by following the phone's instructions. Refer to your phone's user manual for more information. After a few seconds the phone will list the "GH-1003" as a discover device. Select it and follow your phone's instructions to select this pairing. Your phone will confirm the pairing, and then press Yes/OK. 	<p>4.3. Pairing by USB Adapter (2.4 GHz)</p> <p>Plug the USB Adapter to the USB Port of a host device(Such as a computer). Press and hold the Mode Button for 3 seconds to switch to Adapter Mode. The Headset will be paired automatically in few seconds.</p> <p>4.4. Connected with 3.5mm Audio Jack</p> <p>Use the 3.5mm Audio Cable provided by the headset, plug any end of the 3.5mm Audio Cable to the 3.5mm Audio Jack of the headset, and then plug the other end to an Audio device.
