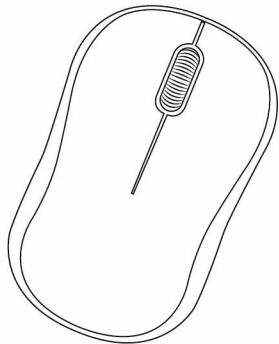

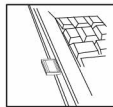
3. Connecting with Computer:

The first time you take out this mouse and receiver from the packing, plug and play function.

Plug the Receiver into PC USB Port. Under Win2000 or higher, wait for the OS to detect the RF device. Under Win 98, installation of driver for the device is necessary.



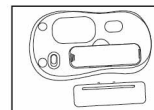
Insert the batteries into the mouse and move it for a while, to start working.

4. Inserting Batteries:

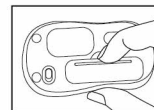
1. Open the back battery compartment cover.



2. Insert 1 x 'AA' batteries (not included) into compartment with correct.



3. Close the battery compartment cover.

5. Trouble Shootings:

- When mouse doesn't respond, check the battery power status.
- Check the battery pole if the optical LED is still off after inserting batteries.
- Ask for maintenance solution from your retailer and engineer.

WARNING:

- Be sure that the batteries are installed correctly. Wrong polarity may damage the unit.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable(nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommend are to be used.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Only adults should replace batteries.
- If the unit is not to be used for an extended period of time, remove the battery.
- Replace the batteries when the unit stops operating properly.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire, batteries may expiode or leak.
