

1. Tips on using tablet

1.Long press the power button for 3-5 seconds to power the device up Once the product is turned on, the following screen will be displayed on your tablet.

2.Basic Operation

Tap : Tap an icon or App once to select the icon or launch the App.

Long-tap: Tap and hold the current operating interface or area until the relevant icons appear, then release.

Slide: Slide up/down/left/ right to switch between different screens conveniently.

Drag: Tap and hold an icon on the desktop and drag to other position.

Pinch & Spread: Use two fingers to tap the screen, and adjust the distance between t hem to zoom in/out the current photo or web contents.

3.Connecting to PC

When connecting to PC, please follow the computer prompts strictly to avoid any data loss.

Do not disconnect the USB connection during data transferring: otherwise it will cause data damage or loss.

- a. Connect the one end of the USB cable (supplied) to the unit and the other end of the USB cable (supplied) to your PC.
- b. Tap Turn on USB storage to transfer files.
