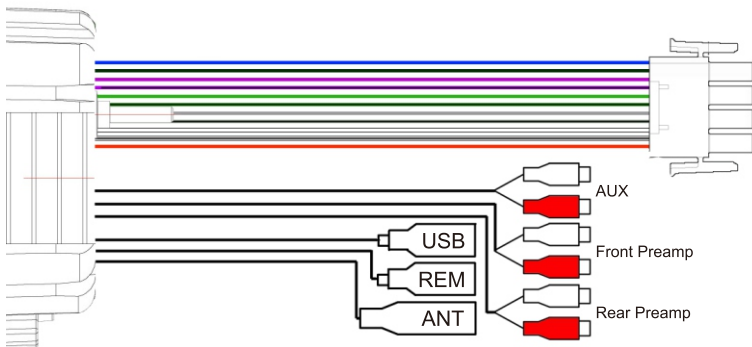

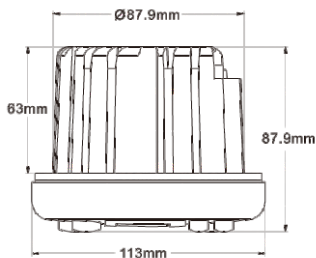
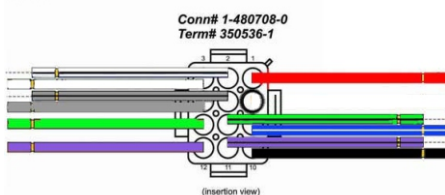

INSTALLATION OVERVIEW



Connection:

- Pin 1- Red-12V Ignition
- Pin 2- White/Blk- Left Front Spkr Neg
- Pin 3- White- Left Front Spkr +
- Pin 4- Empty
- Pin 5- Grey/Blk- Right Front Spkr Neg
- Pin 6- Grey- Right Front Spkr +
- Pin 7- Blue- Remote Turn On
- Pin 8- Green/Blk- Left Rear Spkr Neg
- Pin 9- Green- Left Rear Spkr +
- Pin 10- Black- Ground
- Pin 11- Purple/Blk- Right Rear Spkr Neg
- Pin 12- Purple- Right Rear Spkr +



OPERATION

The button layout below will give you a quick overview of the button functionality.

BUTTONS:

1 - Power

2 - APS

3 - Band

4 - Mode

5 - Volume +

6 - Volume -

7 - Play/Pause

8 - Tune Up

9 - Tune Down



Function:

How To:

Power On	Press the Power (1) button once.
Power Off	Hold the Power (1) button for 2 seconds.
Volume Up	Press the VOL + (5) button.
Volume Down	Press the VOL - (6) button.
Seek Up	Press APS (2) once.
Tune Up	Hold down Tune Up (8).
Tune Down	Hold down Tune Down (9).
Pause/Play	Press Play/Pause (7) once.
Mute	Press Power (1) button once.
Audio/Settings	Hold down Mode (4) button.

Sources

To change any of the sources, press the Mode (4) button on the KMC1. Continue to press Mode until the desired source is reached.

FM Source:

Function:

Seek Up:

Press the APS (2) button once.

Tune Up:

Hold Tune Up (8) button for 1 second. Then press (8) once.

Tune Down:

Hold Tune Down (9) button for 1 second. Then press (9) once.

Mute:

Press the Power (1) button.

AM Source:

Function:

Seek Up:

Press the APS (2) button once.

Tune Up:

Hold Tune Up (8) button for 1 second. Then press (8) once.

Tune Down:

Hold Tune Down (9) button for 1 second. Then press (9) once.

Mute:

Press the Power (1) button.

Presets:

Press and Hold APS (2) button. Programs strongest stations into FM and AM Presets. Pressing Tune Up (8) and Tune Down (9) will change preset stations. To set a custom preset, press Tune Up (8) for desired preset number. Then use Manual Tune to change to desired station. Press Play/Pause to set new station into preset number.

Sources

USB Source:

Function:

Next Track:

Press the Seek Up (8) button once.

Previous Track:

Press the Seek Down (9) button once.

Fast Forward:

Hold Tune Up (8) button.

Rewind:

Hold Tune Down (9) button.

Pause:

Press the Play/Pause (7) button.

Repeat:

Press APS (2) to Repeat 1, Press again to Repeat all.

Search:

Press and Hold APS (2) to search a specific track #, then press VOL+ (5) or VOL- (6) to change to that track #.

Bluetooth (BT) Source:

Function:

Next Track:

Press the Seek Up (8) button once.

Previous Track:

Press the Seek Down (9) button once.

Pause:

Press the Play/Pause (7) button.

BT Source Cont.

Pairing Mode:

When BT MUSIC is flashing, the KMC1 is in pairing mode.

Locate the device name on your phone to pair.

Device Name: Media Center

Disconnect Device:

Press APS (2) button.

Settings

Press and Hold Mode (4) to enter Settings Menu. Press and Release Mode (4) to change Menu Items. To adjust setting, press VOL+ (5) or VOL- (6). Adjustable settings are: Bass, Treble, Balance, Fader, Beep, EQ, Loud, and Tuner Region.

WARRANTY

When purchased from an Authorized KICKER Dealer, CPS warrants this product to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use for a period of ONE (1) YEAR from date of original purchase with receipt. If this product is identified as Refurbished or B Goods, the warranty is limited to a period of THREE (3) MONTHS from the date of original purchase. In all cases you must have the original receipt.
