## Right

### 1. Resetting key

Refresh all information to its original stat.

### 2. Micro-SD Slot

Reads from and writes to the SD card.

### 3/4. USB 3.0 port

Connect peripherals such as external storage devices and printers.

### 5. Earphone port

Connect headphones or a headset (headphone and microphone combo).



## Left

### 1. Kensington

Connect to MEGABOOK security lock.

### 2. LED Indicators

Power-on and charging indicators.

Connect a power adapter to power up your MEGABOOK and charge the battery.

### 5. USB 3.1 port



## Base
