
# WATER DANCING SPEAKERS



### **Power Supply Set Up**


- Connect the Left Speaker Connector Cable (B) to the Right Speaker Input Jack (F).
- Plug USB Power Cable (H) into Left Speaker USB Power Input Jack (D).
- Connect to your computer or USB power supply with the USB Cable (H). Slide Power Switch (E) to "ON" position.

#### **Connect with Blue Tooth**

- Set up power supply. Activate the Blue Tooth function in your Blue Tooth device.
- Select"19T"on your Blue Tooth device for pairing.
- Start music play on your Blue Tooth device. Adjust the volume to activate an amazing sound and light show!

# **Connect with Stereo Plug**

- Set up power supply. Plug 3.5 mm Mini Plug Cable (G) into Audio Jack (C) on Left Speaker. Reduce volume to minimum and connect the 3.5 mm Mini Plug Cable to your music player.
- Adjust the volume to activate an amazing sound & light show!



## **Troubleshooting**

No Sound/ No Response

- · Adjust volume on your music source
- · Make sure that your Blue Tooth device is within range.
- · Check if you have selected the correct audio source.
- · Restart the speakers by turning off the Power Switch.
