


### BATTERIES & CHARGING

The blaster uses 2 "AA" 1.5V batteries (not included)

- 1. Flip open the battery door located at the bottom of the grip.
- 2. Insert the batteries following the diagram inside the battery compartment.
- 3. Close the battery compartment.

# DOWNLOADING THE APP

- 1. Scan the correct QR code to the right to download the AR Blaster app from Google Play™ or the The App Store®.
- 2. Turn on Bluetooth® on your smartphone.




# AUGMENTED REALITY LASER GAME

## ASSEMBLY

- Insert the threaded end of the smartphone mount into the mounting hole on the top of the blaster's barrel.
- Rotate the smartphone mount clockwise until it is firmly attached. The open end of the mount should face backward towards the user.
- Lift the top end of the spring-loaded mount and insert the phone. Be careful not to trap any buttons. You may need to remove any protective case.







## CONNECTING WITH THE BLASTER

The blaster connects with the smartphone via Bluetooth®. Make sure that Bluetooth® is enabled on your device.

- 1. Launch the AR Blaster app.
- 2. Pull and hold the AR Blaster's trigger for approximately 3 seconds.
- 3. The app will search for the Blaster.
- a. If it doesn't find the Blaster, tap on the Blaster icon at the bottom of the screen.
- b. A list of available connections will appear.
- c. Move the slider to the right of the Blaster's name to the right.
