Note: The mirror can rotate 270 degrees, not 360 degrees. 1 side of the mirror is 1x and the other side is 7x magnification.

Fully charge before first use

CONNECTING:

- Make sure Bluetooth® is enabled on your device.
- Press the power button to turn on the unit. You will hear a beep.
- 3. Press and hold the power button, you will hear voice prompt "Waiting for device".
- 4. On your device, search for Bluetooth® devices and select "VANITY MIRROR". You will hear a beep and the Bluetooth® Indicator light will remain on when a device is successfully paired.

Note: Volume is controlled by both your device and the BT Vanity Mirror. Check your device's volume if volume is too low.

FRONT PANEL FUNCTIONS:

- Bluetooth® Power Press to turn speaker on (BT Indicator LED light will blink slowly) and press again to turn off (BT Indicator LED light will turn off). Long press to enter pair mode (BT Indicator LED light will blink quickly). BT Indicator Light will turn blue and remain constant when device is paired to mirror.
- Bluetooth® Indicator light flashes quicker when in pairing mode.
- Play/Pause/Answer Press to pause/play music. Music will pause automatically when a call is incoming. Press to answer call and press again to end call and resume music.
- Plus Volume/Skip Long press to increase volume. Press to skip to the next song
- Minus Volume/Skip Long press to decrease volume. Press to skip to the previous song
- Charge Indicator Light will turn red when mirror has 10% battery life. While charging, LED will be on until mirror is fully charged
- Light Power Press to turn light on, press again to dim, press again to turn light off. Note: light will time out after 25 minutes

SIDE PANEL FUNCTIONS:

- Auxiliary Use to play music through your auxiliary supported devices. Auxiliary input only
- B. USB - Charge your cell phone or other USB powered devices. Provided Power Adapter is needed to use this function.
- C. Micro USB port - Use to plug in your Power Adapter


