With respect to the materials, information, and description contained in Exhibits 3 and 4 of the Application (collectively, the "Technical Details"), such Technical Details contain trade secrets and proprietary information not customarily released to the public. Such Technical Details are available only to certain employees and contractors of Ubicquia with a need to know and who are subject to obligations of confidentiality to Ubicquia, such as confidentiality or non-disclosure agreements ("NDAs"). The public disclosure of these Technical Details would be harmful to Ubicquia and provide unjustified benefits to its competitors.

The Subject Product is not accessible to the public because it is mounted atop a streetlight luminaire by trained installers using bucket lift trucks. The installers are contractors of Ubicquia or its customers, as applicable, and are subject to confidentiality obligations no less stringent than the confidentiality obligations of Ubicquia's customers.
