Before using the unit, be sure to read all operating instructions carefully. Please note that these are general precautions and may not pertain to your unit. For example, this unit may not have the capability to be connected to an outdoor antenna.

- 1. Read these instructions: All the safety and operating instructions should be read before the product is operated.
2. Keep these instructions: The safety and operating instructions should be retained for future reference.
3. Heed all warning: All warnings on the product and in the operating instructions should be adhered to.
4. Follow all instructions: All operating and use instructions should be followed.
5. Do not use this apparatus near water: Do not use the product near water and moisture. For example, near a bathtub, washbowl, kitchen sink and laundry tub, in a wet basement, or near a swimming pool.
6. Clean only with dry cloth: Unplug this product from the wall outlet before cleaning. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners. Use a dry cloth for cleaning.
7. Do not block any ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Slots and openings in the cabinet and in the back or bottom are provided for ventilation, to ensure reliable operation of the product and to protect it from overheating. These openings must not be blocked or covered. The openings should never be blocked by placing the product on a bed, sofa, rug or other similar surface. This product should never be placed near or over a radiator or hear source. This product should not be placed in a built-in installation such as a bookcase or rack unless proper ventilation is provided or the manufacturer's instructions have been adhered to.
8. Do not install near any hear sources such as radiators, hear registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
9. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong. The wide blade or the third prong is provided for your safety. 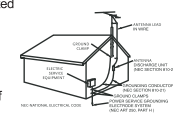

16. Power lines: An outside antenna system should not be located in the vicinity of overhead power lines or other electric light or power circuits, or where it can fall into such power lines or circuits. When installing an outside antenna system, extreme care should be taken to keep from touching such power lines or circuits as contact with them might be fatal.

17. Overloading: Do not overload wall outlets and extension cords as this can result in a risk or fire or electric shock.

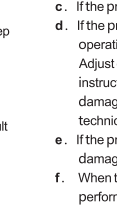
18. Object and liquid entry: Never push objects of any kind into the product through as they may touch dangerous voltage points or short out parts that could result in fire or electric shock. Never spill or spray any type of liquid on the product.

19. Outdoor antenna grounding: If an outside antenna is connected to the product, be sure the antenna system is grounded so as to provide some protection against voltage surges and built up static charges. Section 810 of the National Electrical Code, ANSI/NFPA 70, provides information with respect to proper grounding of the mast and supporting structure, grounding of the lead-in wire to an antenna discharge product, size of grounding conductors, location of antenna discharge product, connection to grounding electrodes and requirements for the grounding electrodes.



The lightning flash with arrowhead symbol, within an equilateral triangle, is intended to alert user to the presence of uninsulated 'dangerous voltage' within the product's enclosure, that may be of sufficient magnitude to constitute a risk of electric shock.

The exclamation point within an equilateral triangle is intended to alert the user to the presence of important operating and maintenance (servicing) instruction in the literature accompanying the appliance.



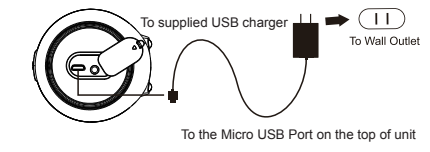

25. POWER SOURCE:

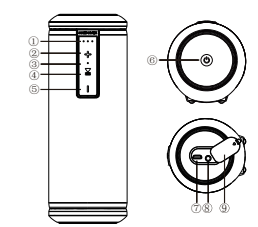
- The unit has a built in Li-ion rechargeable battery, recharge it before use or when it is drained as follows:
1. Open the Rubber Cover on the top unit. (This cover is for water and dusts Ingress Protection, always make sure it is completely close.)
2. Connect the Micro USB Plug from the supplied USB Connection Cable to the Micro USB Port.
3. Connect the full sized USB Plug from the supplied USB Connection Cable to the USB Port on the supplied USB Charger to start charging.
• During charging, the Red Indicator on the front of unit will illuminate. When finished, it will turn off.
• This AC/USB Adaptor is intended to be correctly orientated in a vertical or floor mount position.
• To save energy, unplug the AC/USB Adaptor from the wall outlet if you will not use it for an extended period of time.
• During charging, you can also play and listen music at the same time.



Notes:

- Your battery will last longer if you're following these simple guidelines for charging and storing.
A. Before first time use, charge it approximately 4 hours until the unit is fully charged.
B. Recharge and store the unit within the temperature range of 5°C-35°C (40°F-95°F).
C. Do not charge longer than 24 hours. Excessive charging or running the unit until battery fully drains will damage battery. Battery life will be extended if you keep the battery fully charged.
D. Battery life naturally shortens slowly over time.
E. The rechargeable battery incorporated in this product is not user replaceable.

OPERATION:

- BT (Bluetooth) pairing: First time use or re-pairing the unit to a new BT Device, pair as follows:
1. Power on the unit by pressing and holding the ⏻ Button on the bottom of the unit approximately 3 seconds. The unit will enter to BT (Bluetooth) mode automatically. The Blue Indicator on the front of unit will illuminate and blink.
2. Power on the external BT Device and enter to BT searching mode. Start pairing following the on screen instructions from the external BT Device. After paired, the unit will sound a prompt tone and the Blue Indicator will stop blinking.
3. If pairing is complete you may now play music and answer calls with your external BT Device.
4. During playback:
• Press the ⏸ Button on the unit to pause, press again to resume normal playback.
• Press and holding the + or - Buttons to adjust volume level as desired.
• Press and release the + or - Buttons repeatedly to skip tracks.
5. If the unit is paired to a Cell Phone and a call is incoming during an active music session, press the 📞 Button to pause the music playback then speak to the built-in microphone to answer the call. When your call is complete, press the 📞 Button to disconnect or end the call and resume to music playback.
6. When finished listening, press and hold the ⏻ Button to shut off the unit.

Notes:

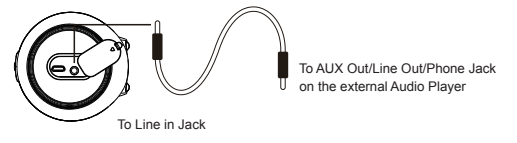
- When the external BT Device searched the unit, our model number "MMA3628" will appear on the display of external BT Device.
• If while pairing you are asked for a code please try "0000" or "1234".

Normal operation after pairing:

- 1. Power on the unit by pressing and holding the ⏻ Button on the bottom of the unit approximately 3 seconds. The unit will enter to BT (Bluetooth) mode automatically. The Blue Indicator on the front of unit will illuminate and blink.
2. Wait a few seconds until the unit is automatically paired to the external BT Device. (The Blue Indicator will stop blinking).
3. After pairing is complete you may now play music and answer calls with your external BT Device.

AUX (in):

- To listen from an external Audio Player such as a MP3 Player, Discman ...etc.
1. Open the Rubber Cover on the top of unit. (This cover is for water and dusts Ingress Protection, always make sure it is completely closed after open).
2. Connect one end of the supplied Audio Connection Cable to the AUX Out/Line Out/Phone Jack on the external Audio Player.
3. In power on mode, connect the other end of the cable to the AUX (in) Jack as the figure below. The unit will turn to AUX IN mode automatically. The Green AUX (in) Indicator will illuminate.



- 4. Play the music on the connected Player as usual. (Make sure the volume level of the connected Audio Player is turned to high level.)
5. During playback:
• Press the 📞 Button to mute the sound, press again to turn the sound back.
• Press and holding the + or - Buttons to adjust volume level as desired.
6. When no longer in use, press and hold the ⏻ Button to shut off the unit.

Note: If the Audio Connection Cable was plugged into the AUX (in) Jack, the Bluetooth function will auto cut. Unplug the Cable from the AUX (in) Jack before use Bluetooth function.

TROUBLESHOOTING:

Table with 3 columns: Symptom, Cause, and Solution.
