





BASIC OPERATION

CONNECTING POWER ADAPTOR

Connect the power adaptor plug to the DC 5V socket in the back of the unit and the other end into the standard AC outlet.

 Do not plug or unplug the power cable while you have wet hands

- When planning not to use this unit for a long time, disconnect the power cable from the wall outlet.
- When disconnecting the power cord from the wall outlet, do not pull on the cord.

REMOTE CONTROL

First time use the battery has been included (1 x CR2025) please pull out and discard the insulation film in the battery compartment. Once this has been done the remote control will now work. Please note that the IR sensor on the speaker is on the front of the base.

To replace the batteries:

- Press the tab and slide the battery tray as per below
- Replace the battery with a new CR2025 button cell battery, ensure the polarity markings match
- Close the battery tray; please ensure the tray clicks and locks into position.



BLUFTOOTH PLAYBACK

- Ensure the speaker is turned on at the back of the unit, and press the "Power" button on the remote.
- Press the "Mode" button to switch to Bluetooth mode bLUE will be displayed on the LED display.
- 3. Once in bLUE mode, the LED indicator light will flash quickly.
- Turn on your Bluetooth function on your connecting device i.e. Smartphone, MP3 Player or Tablet.
- Scan for new available devices on your device, once you have found "SMESB005/BMESB005" click and connect.
- Once connected the LED indicator will be lit continuously and the Pause icon on the LED display will be shown.

 Please use your device to choose your music and press play, the music will then start playing through the speaker. Once music is playing the LED indicator light will flash slowly and the Play icon will be displayed on the LED display.

Once you have connected your device you can use the remote control or the control panel on the top of the unit to operate the Volume, Skip to the next or previous song, Adjust the EQ setting, Mute the Song, Pause the song. Please refer to the DEVICE OVERVIEW section for details.

<u>NOTE:</u> the Bluetooth function has a connectivity range of 10meters. If you go further than 10metres away the signal might not work.

While in Bluetooth mode if the music has not been played for 10mins the speaker will enter sleep mode, wake the speaker up by pressing the "Power" button on the remote control.

LISTENING TO THE RADIO

- Ensure the speaker is turned on at the back of the unit, and press the "Power" button on the remote
- Press the "Mode" button to switch to FM mode, the FM icon on the LED display will now be lit.
- 3. Once in FM mode press and hold the "SCN" button on the remote or unit for 3 seconds and the unit will automatically tune all the FM stations it has reception of, the screen will display CH01 when the 1st station is tuned and continue through up to 30 stations, when it has completed its scan it will return to CH01
- Press the "I◄ or►I" button on the remote or unit to select the desired channel.
- You can turn the volume up or down by pressing "VOL-"or "VOL+".

AUX IN

The speaker has an AUX input for other audio devices to be able to play through the speakers.

- 1. Ensure the speaker is turned on.
- Connect your audio device via a 3.5mm cable (included) to the back of the speaker.
- Once the cable is connected the speaker will automatically change to "Line In" mode, LINE will be displayed on screen.
- Press play on your device to ensure it is playing. And use the volume controls on your device and the speaker to adjust the volume.

NOTE: When the 3.5mm cable is removed the Speaker will return to Bluetooth mode.

EQ SETTING

The speaker allows you to change the EQ setting or know as Equalizer setting. Press the "EQ" button on the remote control while in Bluetooth mode and the EQ setting can be change.

The LED display will show the EQ setting briefly.
