This letter is to ascertain that Otter Products, LLC. Product OtterBox Hardline Series Charging Station Model: OBFTC-0101-A, has been the units used for conducting FCC compliance testing, and it meets KDB 680106 D01 RF Exposure Wireless Charging App v03 Clause 5(b) 6 conditions.

1	Power transfer frequency is less than 1 MHz
	YES; the device operated in the frequency range from 110.5-205KHz.
2	Output power from each primary coil is less than or equal to 15 watts.
	YES. The maximum output power of the primary coil is 15W.
3	The transfer system includes only single primary and secondary coils. This includes charging systems that may have multiple primary coils and clients that are able to detect and allow coupling only between individual pairs of coils.

4	Client device is placed directly in contact with the transmitter.
