IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS




- **CAUTION:** Any changes or modifications to this equipment could void the product warranty.

Installation:


1. Back view

- a. Assemble the transfer board into the socket of the pedestal.
- b. The network cables and power wires go through the stem of the pedestal.
- c. Connect the network cables from network router to the RJ45 sockets on the transfer board.
- d. Connect the power wires from the power supply to jacks CN1,CN2 on the transfer board.




2. Front view

- a. Put the Sync tablets into the trays of the pedestal.
- b. Connect the cables from tablets to CN3, CN4 on the transfer board.

3. Turn on/ Turn off

- a. Supply AC power to the pedestal, the tablet will automatically turn on.
- b. Disconnect AC power to the pedestal, the tablet will be turned off.

4. In the main menu, choose the APK to operate.
