Smart Rod Sensor



Operation Guide

Please scan the QR code or search the Cyberfishing APP from the Google Play or Apple App Store, download and install it in your smartphone.

Charging Your Smart Rod Sensor

Your Smart Rod Sensor comes with a built-in rechargeable battery and a standard USB charging port. Please charge fully before use. Attach magnet charging cable to the Sensor and insert the USB to either a PC or power adaptor to start charging.

Power ON/OFF Your Smart Rod Sensor

Power On: Press and hold the button for 3-4 seconds until the

screen displays.

Notice: If you find nothing displayed, your Smart Rod Sensor may have no power, please charge it.

Power Off: Press and hold the button 3-4 seconds when the screen displays time until the screen goes off.

Notice: Your Smart Rod Sensor goes into a DEMO mode if the sensor is charging and you press the button for 10-11 seconds. To turn off the DEMO mode disattach charging cable then press the button for 3-4 seconds to exit the DEMO mode, then press the button for 3-4 seconds again, the Sensor turns off.

APP Connection & APP Setting

Pairing Your Smart Rod Sensor

First open the Cyberfishing APP. Choose your language and register your account. As soon your signed in the APP starts searching for available Smart Rod Sensors. Make sure your Smart Rod Sensor is turned on. Name your Sensor, scan or type the serial number of your Sensor printed on the packaging box for SRS3 and on the charging cable tag for SRS8.

Choose your fishing type, save data and Cyberfishing APP is ready to Start Fishing.

Notice: Your Smart Rod Sensor must to be connected with

smartphone by Cyerfishing APP, do not connect them by smartphone OS Bluetooth.

Setting

Set up yur profile or download from your Facebook page. Set up oyr tackle box with your fishing tackle.

Smart Rod Sensor Operation

As soon as you connected Smart Rod Sensor with Cyberfishing APP, your Sensor is ready and it is in a CAST mode. After 5 sensors screen turns off, but your Sensor is ready to work and will count your casts automatically.

To record your catches, use CATCH mode by pressing the button one time from the CAST mode or two times from dark screen (first to wake up the Sensor). There is a green lite on the Sensor flashes one time and your phone sound and vibrate to confirm your CATCH. You can modify type of CATCH from APP setting.

To make your spots, use MARKER mode by pressing the button two times from the CAST mode or three times from dark screen (first to wake up the Sensor). There is a red lite on the Sensor flashes one time and your phone sound and vibrate to confirm your MARKER.

You can modify type of MARKER from APP setting.

After fishing

After fishing, you can check statistics of your fishing trip in the Cyberfishing APP or from [www. Cyberfishing.com](http://www.Cyberfishing.com)
