

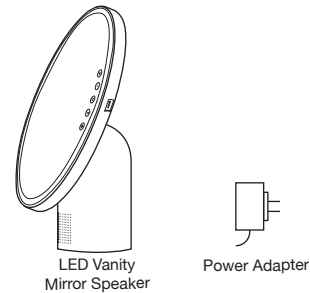
# LED VANITY MIRROR SPEAKER

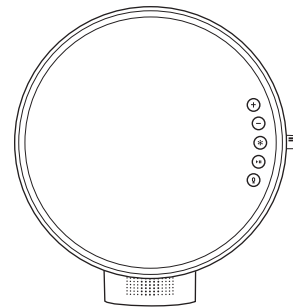

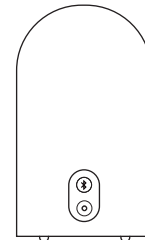
## FRONT-PANEL CONTROLS

- ⊕ Volume Up – Long press to increase volume.
- ⊖ Volume Down – Long press to decrease volume.
- ⊕ Light Power – Press to turn light on, press again to dim, press again to turn light off.
- ⊕ Play/Pause – Press to play/pause music. Music will pause automatically when a call is incoming.
- ⊕ Answer – Press to answer call and press again to end call and resume music.



## REAR-PANEL CONTROLS

- ⊕ Bluetooth Button – Press to activate Bluetooth for pairing. Press again to turn off Bluetooth.
- ⊕ Adapter Port – Plug in a power adapter (included).



## CONNECTING

1. Make sure Bluetooth® is enabled on your device.
  2. Press the Bluetooth® Button on the unit. You will hear a sound.
  3. On your device, select “SI MIRROR SPEAKER”. You will hear a sound to indicate a device is successfully paired.
  4. You are now ready to stream your favorite music!
- NOTE: Volume is controlled by both your device and the LED Vanity Mirror Speaker. Check both if the volume is too low.
