Getting Started

What's included

ZIKTO Walk, Cradle, USB Cable, Brief Manual



How to secure your Walk


Put on your Walk and align both ends of the straps so that they overlap each other with the clasp. Make sure it best fits your wrist.

Squeeze the clasp and the straps until you hear a smooth click to make sure your Walk is securely fastened.


Changing straps

Put off your Walk and place it on a table.


Locate small *gaps at the end of the straps. (*near the adjoining part of the straps and the device.)



1. Try carefully forcing spring bars with a *tool until they are completely separated from the device. Make sure you hold your Walk securely with the other hand while putting it on a table. (***It comes with optional strap packages.**)



(Or hold your *tool the opposite way and carefully stick it into the hole until the strap pops up by the spring bar.)



2. Other optional straps come with *Quick Release Spring Bar that allows you to easily replace straps without the tool.

Care and wearing tips

Wear your Walk loosely enough to allow air circulation.

Keep your Walk dry and clean on a regular basis.

If you experience any types of irritation on your skin or feeling discomfort, please discontinue use.

Size guide(*wrist size)

ZIKTO Walk comes with a pair of silicon straps that gives you ultimate comfort. And of course, we have straps interchangeable to appeal a wide range of personal style. We have leather straps and MOREE braided straps available for you.

Since they are different material with distinct properties, each of them needs different scale for measuring size.

The followings are our recommended size guide based on your *wrist size:

Silicon

150mm - 210mm (5.9" - 8.2")
120mm - 165mm (4.7" - 6.5")

Leather

170mm - 205mm (6.7" - 8.0")
155mm - 180mm (6.1" - 7.0")

MOREE

130mm ~ 190mm (5.1" - 7.5")
120mm ~ 180mm (4.7" - 7.0")

Setting up your Walk on a mobile device

Mobile device requirements(iOS)

ZIKTO Walk is capable of setting up and syncing with select mobile devices that support *Bluetooth 4.0(BLE) technology.

iOS 8 and above / Bluetooth 4.0(BLE) devices

Installing the app

You can find the ZIKTO app on the iOS App store by searching for "ZIKTO".

If you already have the app installed, please check out for our available updates to make sure you have the latest version to enjoy.

Pairing

Unlike other Bluetooth devices, your Walk must be paired directly through the ZIKTO app.

*NOT through the setting app on your iOS device.

Syncing

Your Walk syncs to supported iOS devices via Bluetooth.(Bluetooth 4.0 BLE)

Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device and start syncing by pressing a sync button on your app.

Mobile device requirements(Android)

ZIKTO Walk is capable of setting up and syncing with select mobile devices that support *Bluetooth 4.0(BLE) technology.

Android 4.3 and above / Bluetooth 4.0(BLE) devices

Installing the app

Pairing

Unlike other Bluetooth devices, your Walk must be paired directly through the ZIKTO app.

*NOT through the setting app on your Android device.

Syncing

Your Walk syncs to supported Android devices via Bluetooth.(Bluetooth 4.0 BLE)

Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device and start syncing by pressing a sync button on your app.

Phantom LED Display™

[Check the key(button) on the side of your Walk before you go on.]

Your Walk features the Phantom LED Display that consists of 119(7x17) micro holes with LED indicator lights behind. it provides different types of icons and indications depending on the following:

1. Interaction

Power On

Once your Walk goes off, you can turn it on by docking your Walk on a provided charging cradle. Once it is successfully docked, an icon pops up to tell you it is turned on.

Watch

With the first press, Your Walk tells time.



Step Count(Pedometer)

With the second press, it shows how many steps you have made.



Sound Walking

With the third press, it shows your Sound Walking score on the basis of 99 points.



Call

With the fourth press, it tells how many phone calls you have missed.



SMS

With the fifth press, it tells how many messages you have missed.



Remaining Battery

With *quickly pressing the button twice, it tells remaining battery.



Level of Achievement

Weather

With pressing the button for 3-4 seconds, Your Walk tells today's updated weather information.



Sync

When you try syncing your Walk to your mobile device it shows sync icon on the display to tell you that sync is in progress.

2. Notification

Out of battery

When the battery starts dying, it gently alerts you with a battery(remaining) icon.

Call

When you are getting a phone call, a simple LED animation with a call icon pops up to notify you.

SMS

Once you receive a message, a simple LED animation with a SMS icon pops up.

2. Charging

Once docked

Once your Walk is securely docked on a provided charging cradle, it shows how much battery life your Walk has left with.

While charging

After showing how much battery life your Walk has left with, it starts telling time and shows how much battery life has been charged at the same time with a simple gauge bar. (The gauge bar will blink, meaning that your Walk is in the middle of charging.)

fully charged

It tells time with a simple gauge bar.(The gauge bar stops blinking as it is fully charged)

Once docked(with the battery dead)

It shows a simple animation to tell you have your Walk back!

Features

Walking Posture Adjustment

ZIKTO Walk gives a gentle reminder with a vibration on your wrist. when you have such bad walking postures as looking at a mobile phone, putting hands in a pocket, and hunching your back.

You can monitor your walking postures, scores and progresses on the app.

Body Balance analysis

ZIKTO Walk tracks your body balance by comparing the swings of left and right arms. It tells you which part of your body is out of shape by telling your balance score. It also recommends a personalized workout routine in accordance to your balance score.

Biometric Authentication

ZIKTO Walk allows you to unlock your mobile devices(or PC and MAC) with unique walking pattern.(Size of arc, tempo, angle and frequency of your arm swing are the key factors for biometrics.)

Activity Tracker + Sleep Monitoring

ZIKTO Walk tracks everything from steps taken, distance traveled, calories burned to hours slept. You can monitor your daily activities and analyze weekly/monthly trends on downloaded app.

Call/SMS Notification

ZIKTO Walk gives you a gentle vibration on your wrist when you get a call or a message.








