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GENERAL INFORMATION

Product Description for Equipment under Test (EUT)

The *TESONIC INTERNATIONAL(HK) LTD*.'s product, model number: *PCA3200 (FCC ID: 2AEW6TES002)* (the "EUT") in this report was a *selfie sticks*, which was measured approximately: 31.5 cm (L) x 11.1 cm (W) x 2.5 cm (H), rated input voltage: DC3.7V rechargeable Li-ion battery or DC5V charging from USB port.

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Note: The series products, model PCA3200, SS2-1000,SS2-1020,SS2-1040,SS2-1050,SS2-1088,SS2-1080 are electrically identical, the difference between them are just the model name and color of appearance, we selected PCA3200 for fully testing, the detail was explained in the attached declaration letter.

All measurement and test data in this report was gathered from production sample serial number: 150714001 (Assigned by BACL, Dongguan). The EUT was received on 2015-07-14.

Objective

This report is prepared on behalf of *TESONIC INTERNATIONAL(HK) LTD*. in accordance with Part 2, Subpart J, Part 15, Subparts A, B and C of the Federal Communications Commission's rules

The tests were performed in order to determine the Bluetooth BDR of EUT compliance with FCC Part 15, Subpart C, and section 15.203, 15.205, 15.207, 15.209 and 15.247 rules.

Test Methodology

All measurements contained in this report were conducted with ANSI C63.4-2009, American National Standard for Methods of Measurement of Radio-Noise Emissions from Low-Voltage Electrical and Electronic Equipment in the range of 9 kHz to 40 GHz.

All emissions measurement was performed and Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Dongguan).

Test Facility

The Test site used by Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Dongguan) to collect test data is located on the No.69 Pulongcun, Puxinhu Industrial Zone, Tangxia, Dongguan, Guangdong, China

Test site at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Dongguan) has been fully described in reports submitted to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). The details of these reports have been found to be in compliance with the requirements of Section 2.948 of the FCC Rules on February 06, 2015. The facility also complies with the radiated and AC line conducted test site criteria set forth in ANSI C63.4-2009.



Applicable Standard

According to §15.247(i) and §1.1310, systems operating under the provisions of this section shall be operated in a manner that ensure that the public is not exposed to radio frequency energy level in excess of the Commission's guideline.

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According to KDB447498 D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v05r02:

The 1-g and 10-g SAR test exclusion thresholds for 100 MHz to 6 GHz at test separation distances \leq 50 mm are determined by:

[(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW)/(min. test separation distance,

mm)] $\cdot [\sqrt{f(GHz)}] \le 3.0$ for 1-g SAR and ≤ 7.5 for 10-g extremity SAR, where

- f(GHz) is the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz
- Power and distance are rounded to the nearest mW and mm before calculation
- The result is rounded to one decimal place for comparison
- 3.0 and 7.5 are referred to as the numeric thresholds in the step 2 below

The test exclusions are applicable only when the minimum test separation distance is \leq 50 mm and for transmission frequencies between 100 MHz and 6 GHz. When the minimum test separation distance is \leq 5 mm, a distance of 5 mm according to 5) in section 4.1 is applied to determine SAR test exclusion.

Measurement Result

The maximum target output power= -8.82 dBm (0.13mW) at 2402 MHz [(max. power of channel, mW)/(min. test separation distance, mm)][$\sqrt{f(GHz)}$] = 0.13/5*($\sqrt{2.402}$) = 0.040< 3.0

So the stand-alone SAR evaluation is not necessary.

According to FCC § 15.203, an intentional radiator shall be designed to ensure that no antenna other than that furnished by the responsible party shall be used with the device. The use of a permanently attached antenna or of an antenna that uses a unique coupling to the intentional radiator shall be considered sufficient to comply with the provisions of this Section. The manufacturer may design the unit so that a broken antenna can be replaced by the user, but the use of a standard antenna jack or electrical connector is prohibited.

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Antenna Connector Construction

The EUT has one integral antenna arrangement, which was permanently attached and the antenna gain is 0 dBi, fulfill the requirement of this section. Please refer to the EUT photos.



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The setup of EUT is according with per ANSI C63.4-2009 measurement procedure. The specification used was with the FCC Part 15.207 limits.

The spacing between the peripherals was 10 cm.

The adapter was connected to a 120 VAC/60 Hz power source.

EMI Test Receiver Setup

The EMI test receiver was set to investigate the spectrum from 150 kHz to 30 MHz.

During the conducted emission test, the EMI test receiver was set with the following configurations:

Test Procedure

During the conducted emission test, the adapter was connected to the outlet of the first LISN.

Maximizing procedure was performed on the six (6) highest emissions of the EUT.

All data was recorded in the Quasi-peak and average detection mode.

Corrected Amplitude & Margin Calculation

The basic equation is as follows:

Herein,

 V_{C} : corrected voltage amplitude V_{R} : reading voltage amplitude A_{C} : attenuation caused by cable loss

VDF: voltage division factor of AMN or ISN

The "Margin" column of the following data tables indicates the degree of compliance within the applicable limit. For example, a margin of 7dB means the emission is 7dB below the maximum limit. The equation for margin calculation is as follows:





The radiated emission tests were performed in the 3 meters test site, using the setup accordance with the ANSI C63.4-2009. The specification used was the FCC 15.209, and FCC 15.247 limits.

The external I/O cables were draped along the test table and formed a bundle 30 to 40 cm long in the middle.

The spacing between the peripherals was 10 cm.

EMI Test Receiver & Spectrum Analyzer Setup

The system was investigated from 30 MHz to 25 GHz.

Test Procedure

Maximizing procedure was performed on the highest emissions to ensure that the EUT complied with all installation combinations.

Data was recorded in Quasi-peak detection mode for frequency range of 30 MHz - 1 GHz, peak and average detection modes for frequencies above 1 GHz.

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Corrected Amplitude & Margin Calculation

The Corrected Amplitude is calculated by adding the Antenna Factor and Cable Loss, and subtracting the Amplifier Gain from the Meter Reading. The basic equation is as follows:

Corrected Amplitude = Meter Reading + Antenna Factor + Cable Loss - Amplifier Gain

The "Margin" column of the following data tables indicates the degree of compliance with the applicable limit. For example, a margin of 7dB means the emission is 7dB below the limit. The equation for margin calculation is as follows:



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
Conducted Spurious Emissions at Antenna Port




Middle Channel




DH1: High Channel


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DH3: Low Channel

DH3: Middle Channel



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

DH5: Low Channel



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
DH5: Middle Channel

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

Output Power, Low Channel






