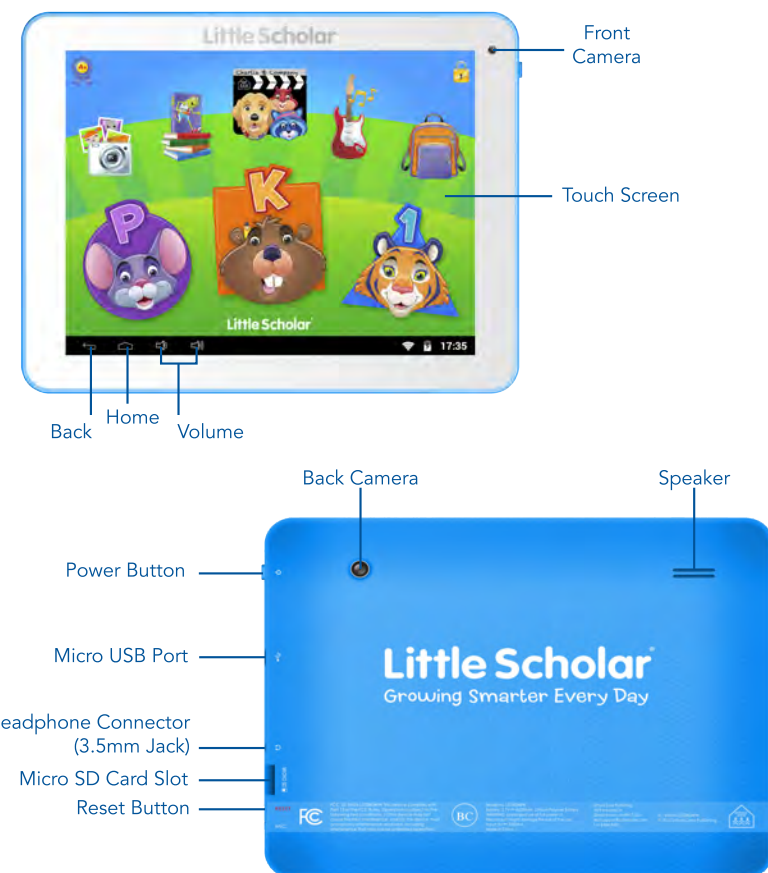

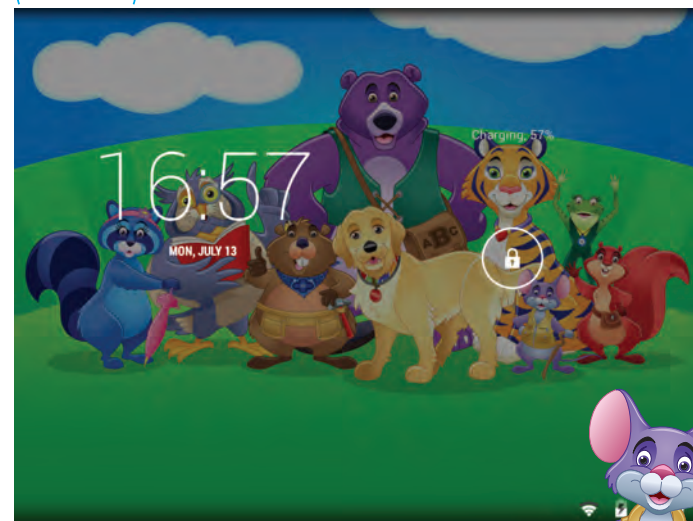
PACKAGE CONTENTS

TURN LITTLE SCHOLAR ON

1. Turn Little Scholar on by pressing the Power Button for 10 seconds.
2. The School Zone logo will indicate that the tablet is loading correctly.
3. When the lock screen appears, swipe the lock icon to the right to unlock.
4. Little Scholar is ready to play!

(Lock Screen)

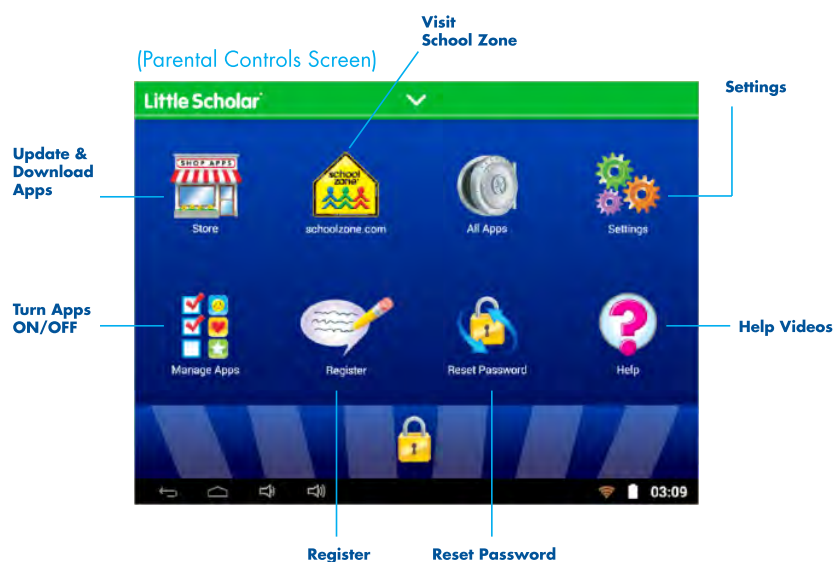


GET TO KNOW PARENTAL CONTROLS

Manage your Little Scholar settings within the password-protected Parental Controls Center.

UNLOCK YOUR PARENTAL CONTROLS

1. Access Parental Controls by choosing located in the upper right corner on the Home Screen.
2. Enter default password **123** and choose "Submit." The tablet is now unlocked. Reset the password in the Parental Controls Center.



RESET PASSWORD

1. Choose in the Parental Controls Center.
2. Enter new password of your choice.
3. Confirm the password by choosing "Submit."

IMPORTANT: Reset password to ensure that your child cannot access parent-only functions, including the Internet browser.

CONNECT TO Wi-Fi

1. Choose in the Parental Controls Center and slide Wi-Fi switch to "ON."
2. Choose your network and connect with your wireless password.

NOTE: When you have successfully connected to the network, the word "Connected" will appear below the network name, and the Wi-Fi signal icon will turn to white.

IMPORTANT: Once you have a Wi-Fi connection, make the most of your Little Scholar by registering to receive updates, notifications, and special offers.

REGISTER

1. Choose in the Parental Controls Center.
2. Choose "Agree" once you have read the Terms of Use.
3. Fill out contact information and choose "Submit."

DOWNLOAD APPS

Enter the School Zone Store for additional apps, all approved by School Zone. Little Scholar is also compatible with Android-based apps found through the Amazon App Store.

ACCESS INTERNET BROWSER

Choose the icon to access the Internet browser.

UPDATE APPS

1. Choose in the Parental Controls Center.
2. Choose "Updates."
3. Choose "Update All."

IMPORTANT: Check back regularly for app updates.

SYSTEM UPDATES

1. Make sure you're connected to Wi-Fi and the tablet is at least 50% charged.
2. Choose in the Parental Controls Center.
3. Scroll down and choose the "About Tablet" icon.
4. Choose "Wireless Update" found towards the top of the screen.
5. Choose "Check for Updates" to see if there are any updates available.
6. If there are new updates available, choose "Download."
7. Once the download is complete, choose "Update Now."
8. Choose "OK."
9. Once the system update is complete, choose "OK."
