

## BLUETOOTH HEADSET MANUAL

### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The name: Sport Bluetooth headset  
 Charging voltage: DC 5V  
 Charging time: 1.5-2 hours  
 Talking time: 3.5 hours  
 Music time: 3.5 hours  
 Stand-by time: 120 hours  
 Apply for all mobile phone, computer, PC with bluetooth

### CHARGE MODE

The headset is powered with rechargeable battery, before using for your first time, pls full charge the battery.

1. Plug the usb cable into the charging port.
2. When it is charging, the red light on.
3. It take about 1-2 hours to full charge the battery.
4. When it is full charged, the red light off and blue light on.

### POWER ON/OFF

- A. Press the multifunction button 2s, voice prompt "Power on", and blue light twinkle.
- B. Press the multifunction button 4s, the red light lit once and with voice prompt "power off".

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Ready for pairing  
 Press the multifunction button 4s, the headset will enter pairing mode. The red and the blue lights twinkle alternately.  
 Language Switch  
 When the headset standby, Press "V+" button 6s, it switch language between Chinese and English. (operating this before pairing.)

Pairing on Mobile  
 Turn on the bluetooth on your mobile, search and connect. When succeeded, voice prompt 1. "Paired" or 2. "your phone is connected"  
 Dial last number

When headset is in standy mode with your mobile connected, double-pressing the multifunction button, voice prompt "du", loose your hand and then the device will dial last number.

Cancel dialing  
 During dialing, one short press the multifunction button to cancel.

Answering a call  
 When there is an incoming call, one short press the multifunction button, to answer the call.

Reject a call  
 When there is an incoming call, press 2s the multifunction button, voice prompt "du" twice, loose your hand, then the call is rejected.

End talking  
 During talking, one short press the multifunction button, talking end.

Mute (MIC)  
 During talking, pressing "v+" 3s, mute on; pressing "v+" 3s again, mute off. (In the mute mode, voice prompt "du" every 10s.)

Conversation Transfer  
 During talking, press the "v-" button 2s, and voice prompt "du", loose your hand, the conversation would transfer to your mobile then; Press again 2s "v-" button, conversation transfered from mobile to the headset.

Voice Dialing  
 In standby mode and with mobile connected, press the "v-" button 2s, when voice prompt "du", loose your hand.

Low Battery Alert  
 When battery voltage is lower than 3.3V, the headset will prompt this once in every 60 seconds.

Low Battery Auto Power Off  
 When battery voltage is lower than 3.0V, the headset will automatically power off.

Music Play/Stop  
 With mobile connected, one short press the multifunction button to play or stop music.

Next Music  
 During music playing, long press "V+" to next music.

Previous Music  
 During music playing, long press "V-" to previous music.

Volume+  
 Short press "V+" button, the volume up. (With mobile connected, when the volume reach maximum, voice prompt " maximum volume")

Volume-  
 Short press "V-" button, volume down.

Connect to 2 mobiles  
 First, succeeded connect to the first mobile, then turn off the first mobile's bluetooth. Reseting the earphone to the pairing mode, and connect it to the second mobile. When the second mobile has been connected succeeded, turn on the first mobile bluetooth and reconnect to the earphone.

2 calls  
 When you are talking and there comes another call:  
 1. Double-press the multifunction button, end current talking and answer the new incoming call.  
 2. One press the multifunction button, hold current talking and answer the new incoming call.  
 3. One press the multifunction button, it switch between the 2 incoming calls.  
 Note: Only your mobile support 2 incoming calls that the above function work.

Auto-connected  
 Once you have paired the mobile and headset, they are able to automatically reconncet when disconnected due to long distance or restart.
