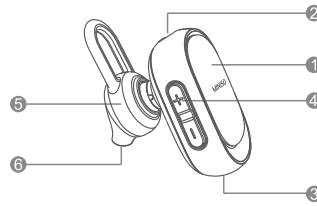


## USER GUIDE

Model:H-21

### About Headset

- 1-Multifunctional Button(on/off, pair, answer calls/hang up)
- 2-USB Waterproof Rubber Plug(built-in Micro USB charging port)
- 3-Button(volume up/down, last/next song)
- 4-Microphone(voice input port)
- 5-Earcap(acoustic design with shocking sound effect)
- 6-Horn Hole(improve airflow when it is vibrating)



### Bluetooth parameter

Bluetooth version: Bluetooth V4.1

### Function features

- ▶ Support high-definition call
- ▶ Support pause / play, last/next song, volume up/down, answer / hang up
- ▶ Support iOS and most of the Android system headset power indication
- ▶ It can connect two devices at the same time
- ▶ Voice prompt function, language switch(Chinese/English)

### Indicator light

Pairing status : Red and blue lights alternately flash  
Pairing is completed : the blue light is flashing  
Music state : the blue light is flashing  
Charging : red light keeps on  
Finished charging : blue light keeps on  
Low power : the red light is on and there is a tone  
The battery runs out : automatically shut down, light off

### Operation description

Power On: Long press the multifunction key for about 2 seconds  
Power Off: Long press the multifunction key for about 3 seconds  
Pairing: Long, press the multifunction key for about 5S to start pairing  
Answer / End a call: Click multifunction key to achieve telephone answering and hanging up  
Rejecting calls: Long press the multifunction key for about 2 seconds to reject a call  
Last/Next Song: Click side button to change songs  
Volume Up/Down: long press the side volume keys to volume up or down  
Redial the Last Number: Double-click to redial the last number  
Voice Dial(need cellphone support): Double-click volume up button"+" to start voice dial  
Broadcast Battery Level: Double-click volume down button"- to start broadcasting battery level  
Headphones Reset System: Press the power button and volume button simultaneously for 5s to restore the pairing list

### Bluetooth matching steps 1

- 1.Please keep as close as possible from Bluetooth headphone to mobile phone (or other connecting devices) within 1 meter.
- 2.Make sure the headset in the off state, press the multifunction key for about three seconds until the red / blue lights flash alternately, it enters into the pairing state, waiting for a connection;
- 3.Open the user's mobile Bluetooth function and search or scan, which will find all Bluetooth devices. Then click the headphone name MINISO-H21 and enter code 0000. After connected successfully, the headphone will turn to blue light blinking which means finishing matching. Now you can listen to music and take a phone call.

### Warm Prompt:

- 1.Mobile already matched will not need to match again, the headphone will automatically match the previous device and make connection.
- 2.Some phones after matching connection, still need to choose headphones service function. If the cell phone bluetooth version is 2.1 or higher, when matching, you don't need to pair password (0000).
- 3.The maximum of matching time is 240 seconds. If you exceeded the time it will exit the matching status. If you still can't match successfully, Please repeat the pairing procedure to connect again.
- 4.The headphone will automatically shut down when it isn't connected over 6 minutes.

### Bluetooth matching steps 2

**Matching 2: One with two function( connect two bluetooth devices at the same time)**

1. Ensure the headset has already connected the first mobile phone( in connection status).
2. Long press the multifunctional button to enter matching status again(red/blue light alternately flashes). Start the Bluetooth function on the other cellphone and search for Bluetooth devices. Choose MINISO-H21 to match and connect(refer to the matching steps 1)
3. Restart the Bluetooth function of the first cellphone and connect MINISO-H21 with connection memory. Then the headphones have already connect two cellphones simultaneously and start the one with two function.

### Steps of connecting computer

First download a universal driver software.Installed successfully , you will have a little gray icon (Bluetooth icon) in the bottom right corner of your computer. Then plug in the Bluetooth adapter, at this time, the gray Bluetooth icon will turn to blue. Note: notebook computer with Bluetooth function does not need external Bluetooth adapter, which needs to buy separately. Right click on the (bluetooth icon ), select "show the classic interface" When the bluetooth headset turned off, long press the multifunctional key, until red and blue lights flashes alternately (matching), headset has entered the being searched state at this time.  
Right click on the computer interface, select the "search" equipment, the headset must be in pairs (red and blue lights flash alternately), then the computer will search for all nearby bluetooth devices. Double-click the computer and search for MINISO-H21 bluetooth headset. Right-click the MINISO-H21 and select "bluetooth high quality audio", enter the password "0000" (0000 initial password). Here, congratulations, bluetooth headset has been successfully connected with computer, and now you can listen to the music and have a voice conversation!

### FAQ

- 1.Headset can't pair with mobile phone.  
Ans:please check whether your headset is in pairing mode or reconnecting mode, check whether Bluetooth search function of your mobile phone has been opened, check your mobile device's Bluetooth menu and delete/forget the headset, reconnect the headset following instructions of user manual
- 2.headset can't be started  
Ans:Please check the battery status of your headset.
- 3:Can I change battery for the headset?  
Ans: No, this headset use a built-in and non-removable Li-Polymer battery .
- 4:Can I use headset while driving?  
Ans: For safety reason, we strongly recommend not to use over-ear headset to avoid distraction while driving.
- 5: Headset disconnect with your Mobile phone within 10 meter.  
Ans: please check if there is metal or other material within relatively close range that interfere Bluetooth connection, as Bluetooth is a wireless technology that is sensitive to objects between the headset and connected devices.
- 6: Can't hear any sound from your computer or mobile phone.  
Ans: Please check whether the output channel of your computer is Bluetooth Audio Device and Bluetooth function of your computer support A2DP profile. And please check volume of your headset, and computer/mobile phone.
